


PIKE EXECUTIVE COUNCIL: This group of young men have been elected by their fellow brothers to run the largest and best fraternity chapter in the world.




With the date of the party now set in stone, a brother quickly realized that actor James Franco was speaking at the Donald L. Civic Center the SAME DAY the party was to be held......




James Franco Speaking At The Civic Center Doing "The Chop".


Coach Jimbo Fisher and Coach Bobby Bowden are both Pikes! Coach Bowden was President of his chapter in college.



Senior punter Cason Beatty was nominated for the Ray Guy Award; also nominated for the Wuerffel Trophy; All ACC; ACC Academic Honor Roll; led the ACC and ranked #12 in the nation averaging 45.2 yards per punt.



Brandon Allen was named Florida State's Top Male Scholar-Athlete for the third consecutive year. The Electrical Engineering major came to FSU after pitching three seasons for Major League Baseball's San Francisco Giants. Brandon wears #40 in honor of his father, also an FSU Pike and All-American forward and NBA pro.


