

As of January 1st, long time Chapter Adviser **Jimmy Keen '73** will step aside and a pair of established, dedicated and experienced Delta Lambda alumni will chart the next era as Chapter Advisors of Florida State's top fraternity.

John Peacock '01 is co-owner of Capital Risk Management, a general insurance, business & commercial insurance company in Tallahassee. John was a Re-Founding Charter member of Delta Lambda in 2001. He played middle linebacker for the Seminoles, and after college continued with professional football as a member of the Titans, Indoor League Professional Football team.

In 2010 John founded Peacock Insurance Agency in Tallahassee. Several adroit professional moves brought him to the executive position he occupies today. John has coached youth league baseball here, served as President of the Capital City Rotary Cub, and was elected to the Board of Directors of the Tallahassee Quarterback Club.

John writes, "Jimmy Keen '73, Scott, Brent Sembler '78, Charlie Barnes '65, Ed Barnes '70, Khuong Phan '01, Eli Nortellus '01, David Rancourt '84 and others have all talked and written about what makes our Delta Lambda special. I feel we are all on the same page with the goal for 2019 to persuade the new EC to go back to the basics. For example: What does it mean to be a Gentlemen? Be Thoughtful. Be Trustworthy. Be reliable, on time/punctual. Take Pride. Keep your word. Send Flowers. Never stop learning. Lead by example. Stay humble and gracious. Be respectful. Forgive don't hold grudges. Guard your reputation. Pay attention to details. ETC. Stress the importance of re-enforcing the relationships that we have built with the university, sororities, national, brotherhood, alumni etc."

Scottie Howell '06 is the Director of Open Government for the Florida House of Representatives. In addition, Scottie is currently serving on recently-elected Governor Ron DeSantis' Transition Team.

Scottie was a student at FSU in 1987 when his brother Seth Howell '84 was a member of the Chapter. "I would have pledged then, but Seth advised me to wait and get settled in. I was supposed to pledge in the fall of 1988 but of course we were gone by then."

After a tour in the United States Air Force, Scottie returned to FSU and finally did join Pike, first as a member of The Firemen and subsequently as a member of the Colony in 1993-94. Delta Lambda was successfully re-established in 2000, and in 2006 all the Firemen and the earlier colony members were offered initiation into the Fraternity. Scottie and his comrades were initiated on April 22, 2006.

Scottie says, "Anything I contribute to Delta Lambda or more broadly to Pi Kappa Alpha is a repayment of what I owe for bringing the Firemen and colony members back into the fold, and leadership of many others over the years. I walk in the footsteps of giants. John Peacock and I share a desire to see Delta Lambda not only survive but thrive, and to do so at the standard set by those who served before us. Though we do not have the experience of Jimmy Keen and others, we meet the task with alacrity and resolve."



Jimmy Keen's Enduring Legacy of Excellence

Rev. Blythe performed the ceremony. Ricky was Pledge Class President in the winter of 1972 and started at tight end for the Seminoles. Jimmy was Pledge Class President the following fall, 1972. They have remained close friends and Brothers since then.

Legend has it that Jimmy was so big and intimidating as a pledge that Pledgemaster **John Howard** '72 simply *appointed* Jimmy as President instead of having elections. True or not, Jimmy never disappointed, and Delta Lambda's largest pledge class to that point in history ran smoothly all the way through initiation. Jimmy's many trophies and awards as a champion weightlifter was inspiration for this *Pikeboy* photo taken around 1973.

Joe Feheley '81 served as Chapter Advisor for a term when Jimmy had to step away. One of America's best 'Top Gun' pilots, Col. Feheley was called back to active

duty a year ago.

On the night of February 9th, 2014, **Jimmy Keen '73** was inducted via Pi Kappa Alpha Ritual into a distinguished cadre of Chapter Advisors who have molded and protected Delta Lambda since its beginning. Keen was recruited after 15 senior alumni advisors met on December 11th to seek a worthy successor to **Doug Russell '79.** After extensive discussion, the alumni identified Jimmy Keen as the most capable candidate for the job of overseeing the chapter.

Keen graciously accepted the challenge and began work on an aggressive agenda. Jimmy had served on the Chapter Advisory Board for five years before being named Chapter Advisor and he had already mapped out his agenda. "I was advised that my goals were too ambitious," he says, "But the results in a short period of time are amazing."

The first priority, and possibly the agenda item with the greatest impact, was creation of a 'hazing contract' which each pledge and Brother was compelled to sign. This practice continues today. Pike has avoided the fate of our rivals who have been kicked off campus for hazing including Sigma Chi, Sig Ep, ATO, FIJI, ZBT and SAE. Most have returned, but the psychological and financial trauma of losing a chapter is one with which we are too familiar.

In taking on the role of Risk Management Advisor, Jimmy enlisted the help of **Don Pumphrey '09** and **Carlos Lindo '04**, both criminal attorneys, and personal injury lawyer **Clint Wallace '01**. Along with Jimmy, they made extended presentations to the Chapter about Florida law and the reality of consequences to the chapter and to individuals involved in hazing. A similar presentation was made to the spring pledge class.

Jimmy re-organized the Chapter Advisory Board and assigned an alumnus as mentor to each major undergraduate office-holder. In addition, leaders were assigned to reinvigorate the Alumni Association. **Eric Carr '01** serves as Alumni President today.

The first monthly e-newsletter appeared in January, 2014. Keen recruited **Charlie Barnes** '65 to do the writing, and **Chris Dietz** '87 (son **Caleb Dietz** '11) to handle the technical production. All of the officers and the entire Chapter Advisory Board are listed in each issue. Chris Dietz took on the task of creating the outstanding chapter website and continues to serve as webmaster. Since mid-2018, former Pikeboy editor **Tim Sheridan** '79 has also been involved as a creative talent enhancing the newsletter.

To protect the Pike House against vandals and intruders, Jimmy and **Brent Sembler** '78 installed a series of security cameras around and inside the property. As Brent's representative, Jimmy oversees all the property management issues which are many and ongoing.

Other Keen initiatives included an "Alumnus of the Month" program, occasional (and successful) golf reunions on his home course at Golden Eagle, and the Delta Lambda Ambassadors.

The 'Ambassadors' of Delta Lambda is a unique Jimmy Keen creation. It is an expression of his vision to recognize iconic Delta Lambda alumni whose contributions to the chapter are primarily internal. His intent in creating the title four years ago was to add one more per year. The first 'Ambassador' designated at such was Bob Hall. Next was Brent Sembler, followed by Andy Miller and Charlie Barnes.

At the conclusion of his tenure as Chapter Advisor, Jimmy said, "Effective January 1st, John Peacock and Scottie Howell will assume the position of Chapter Advisors. I am not stepping down; I am stepping to their side to be available to assist them. The three of us will remain in the loop together. I will continue to serve on the Board as Risk Manager, and as representative of Legends."

Keen and his wife Joey travel back and forth between their home in Golden Eagle and their place in The Villages, south of Ocala. Jimmy retired after a distinguished 43 year career in law enforcement, much of it with the Inspector General's Office of the Florida Department of Corrections.

Brent Wolfe Sembler '78 is Chairman of the Legends of Delta Lambda, owners of the Chapter House. He is considered to be the 'Godfather' of Delta Lambda. In 2000, Brent was recruited to be Chairman of the Legends of Delta Lambda Capital Campaign which raised \$4 million, and he supervised building of the nation's largest fraternity house under a single roof.


Headquartered in St Petersburg, the Sembler Company is an innovative leader in the international shopping center industry. With Jimmy Keen acting for him on the ground in Tallahassee, Brent oversees all things concerning the house.

Brent's son **Logan Sembler '09** is a Delta Lambda alumnus, and his brother **Greg Sembler '80** is an initiate of Beta Pi Chapter at the University of Pennsylvania. Appointed by then-Governor Jeb Bush, Brent is a member of the Florida State University Board of Trustees.

Charlie Barnes '65 is a former Chapter Advisor, and past National Rush Director of Pi Kappa Alpha. His brother Ed Barnes '71 (National Chapter Advisor of the Year in 2005) and cousins Tim Sheridan '79 and Ted Sheridan '84 are all Delta Lambda alumni. His uncle Ed Cubbon '29 was initiated at West Virginia University.

Andy Miller '70 is a former Chapter Advisor and long-time House Corporation President. Andy has been CEO of Seminole Boosters, Inc. since 1975. His mother, his sister and his daughter are all ADPi Sorority alumni from FSU. His brother Bill Miller '74 and his brother-in-law **Bobby Jones '72** are all Delta Lambda alumni. Andy was a primary figure in the success of the Legends of Delta Lambda Campaign.





Delta Lambda Founder and Charter Member **Bob Hall '49** developed a close friendship with Coach **Bobby Bowden '49** (Samford University) when Bob lived in Birmingham as a career executive with Southern Bell and helped FSU football coaches recruit. He has remained active in his Fraternity all his entire adult life.

A World War II veteran (U.S. Army Air Force) Bob was in the first pledge class of the Pi Kappa Colony.

He retired back to Tallahassee in 1987 and when a five year suspension was handed down by the university in 1988, the Pike National Office in Memphis called on Bob and **John French '64** to provide whatever direct oversight to the remaining members was possible under the terrible circumstances.

"John and I tried to meet with the boys once a month," Bob says. "There wasn't much we could do to keep their spirits up, but we wanted them to know that alumni from their own Chapter cared for them."

He became a 'chapter advisor' to The Firemen, and he was involved directly in both the re-colonization in 1993, and in the re-Founding in 2000. Bob's grandson and namesake **Andrew Robert Hall '14** was initiated at Auburn.
