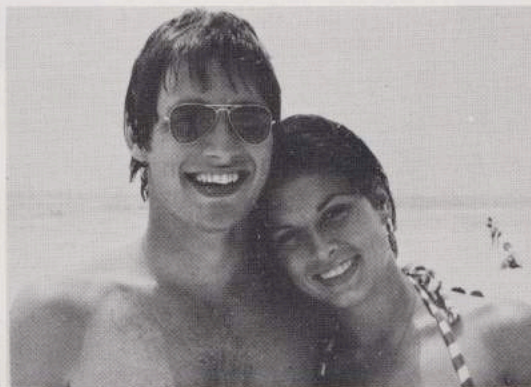
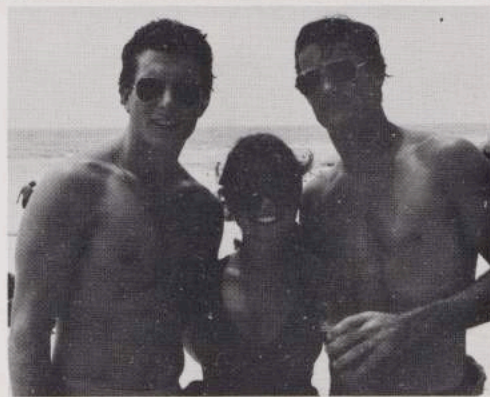


# PI KAPPA ALPHA SPRING WEEKEND

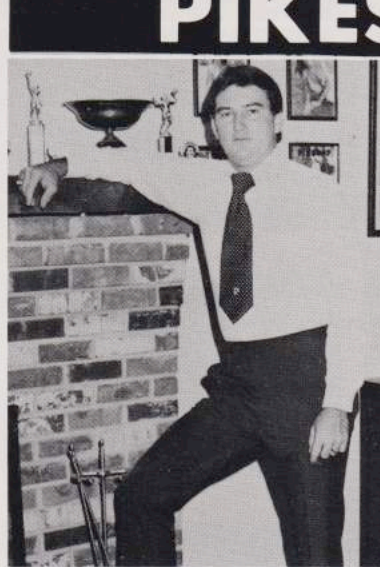
# PIKES ARE CAN



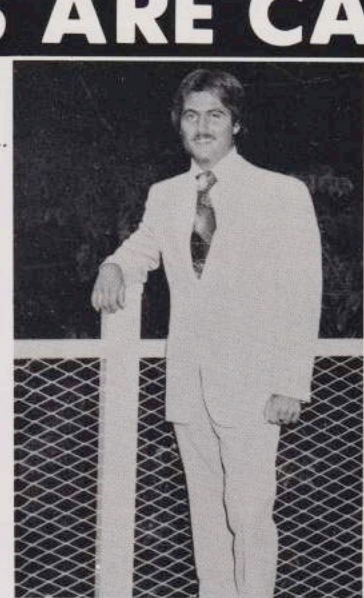

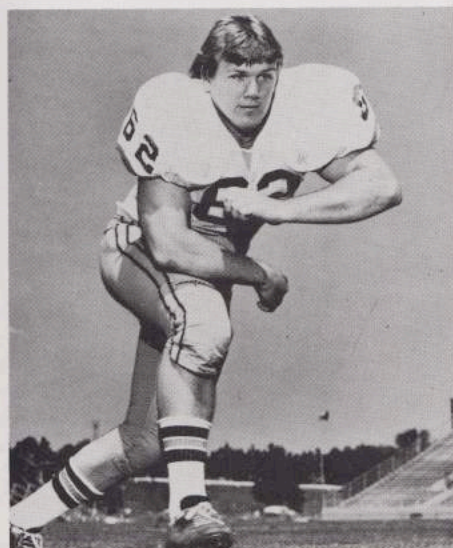
**COACH BOBBY BOWDEN** — Coach Bowden is a **PIKE** from Samford College.



**FRED MILLER** — Fred was a starting Fullback until they moved him to Middle Linebacker where he also started. "Physically, the strongest back among the Seminoles."



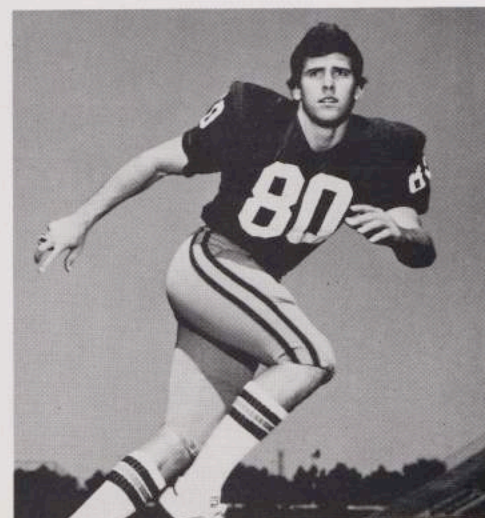

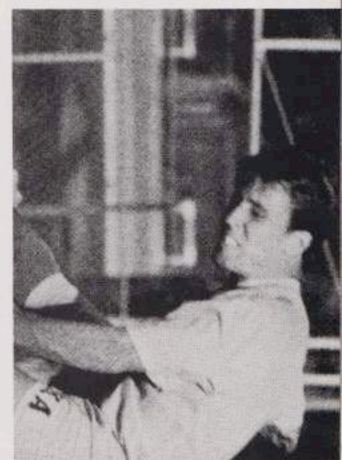

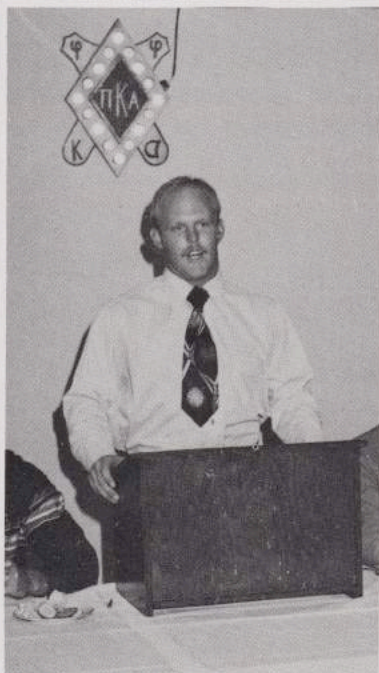


# GUESTS AT THE PIKE HOUSE
