








### Little Sisters Of The Shield And Diamond




#### PIKEBOY VOL. 5: 1977

HILMAR SKAGFEILD— Hilmar is a Pole Vaulter on the Florida State Track Team, and is on Scholarship.



FRED MILLER — Fred was a starting Fullback until they moved him to Middle Linebacker where he also started. "Physically, the strongest back among the Seminoles."




