



This solid athletic tradition covers all of Florida State's 33-year history, from fullback KEN McLEAN, our chapter founder, who caught the first completed pass in Seminole football history; to HUGH ADAMS, FSU's first All-American; to MONTE MAY, FSU's first six-letter man; to TONY ROMEO, the great All-American end of the 1950s, who had an eight year pro career with the Patriots; to **HUBERT GREEN**, golf pro and winner of the U.S. OPEN; to **FRED MILLER**, the first Seminole to letter under the NCAA Freshman rule in 1972; to the stars of today.



Wide receiver PHIL WILLIAMS came to FSU as a walk-on. After earning a scholar-ship, then a starting berth, he was named 1st Team Academic All-American this year as a junior. In addition to maintaining a 3.8 GPA in Accounting, Phil is active in the Fellowship of Christian Athletes and Pi Kappa Alpha Fraternity.



Centerfielder MIKE FUENTES, only a junior, shattered numerous Tribe records on his way to 1st Team All-American status. He led the team in batting (.411 in 56 games), and holds FSU season records in RBIs (76), runs (80), and career homeruns (36). "Of the five longest balls I've ever seen hit", said one sportswriter, "he's got three of 'em".



Team Captain of the 1979 11-0 Seminoles, defensive end SCOTT WARREN signed with the DALLAS COWBOYS this spring, and plans to use his pro career to finance his way through medical school. A four-year starter, Scott was named Most Valuable Defensive Player in the 1977 Tangerine Bowl, was 1st Team Churchman's All-American for three years, was selected as an All-South Independent, and was named 3rd Team All-American (AP) in 1980.



Two year letterman JOHN MADDEN started at center in the 1980 OR-ANGE BOWL, and was voted the team's Best Blocker by the Seminole coaches this spring.

## BOBBY BOWDEN SEMINOLE HEAD COACH



BOBBY BOWDEN is one of college football's great coaches. At Samford University in 1951 he was an All-American quarterback, as well as team captain, and president of his Pi Kappa Alpha chapter. He is one of the nation's Top Ten coaches in winning percentage (.713), and celebrated his 100th career win this year. In 1979 he was named Associated Press All-South Independent Coach Of The Year, and ABC Television's National Coach Of The Year.



Leading the pitching staff in wins is ALL-METRO selection RICK HATCHER (10-3). Just a junior, Rick also has the second lowest ERA on the team.



Lacrosse star JEFF JONES was the team's leading scorer in 1980, and was named to the State ALL- STAR squad. Jeff is also a New York State AAU Golden Gloves Boxing Champion.














## PIKES ARE CAMPUS LEADERS


