


2-TIME ALL-AMERICAN

Centerfielder MIKE FUENTES rewrote both the FSU and NCAA record books as he shattered the legendary Bob Horner's record to become the all-time homerun hitter in college baseball history. The two-time All-American also holds the season records for RBIs, runs, and career homeruns, and is the only Seminole ever to hit over .400 in a single season. single season.

Mike was drafted by the MONTREAL EXPOS after last season.








TTKA'S GRIDIRON TRADITION

Pi Kappa Alpha is presently the **only** Florida State fraternity with members on football scholarship.

Over the last decade, ITKA has had more football players (and more varsity athletes in general) than all the other fraternities combined! Pikes have been linked with Seminole football since the begint from fullback KEN McLEAN - our chapter founder - who caught the first completed pass (1947); to tackle HUGH ADAMS, FSU's first All-American (1949); to All-American end and team capitain TONY ROMEO (1960); to running back FRED MILLER, the first collegian to letter under NCAA's "freshman rule" (1972); to All-American defensive end SCOTT WARREN, (1980); to the stars of today.

Coach BOBBY BOWDEN was an All-American quarterback at Samford University, and president of his Pike chapter there in 1951. Coach Bowden is shown below accepting a plaque from Pike officers recognizing his 100th career win.



RICK JONES follows a long line of Π KAs on the Seminole golf team, including All-Americans HUBERT GREEN, and TERRY & TOM ANTON. Seven Florida State Π KA alumni are currently active golf professionals; four of them tour players.

- PIKES had more men participating in Intramurals than any other fraternity for the eleventh consecutive year!








All-American defensive end SCOTT WARREN adds another notch to his long tally of athletic achievements as he hurles his fourth consecutive discus championship.




"ALL CAMPUS SUPERSTARS CHAMPS . . . AGAIN"


TRACK & FIELD CHAMPIONS




Brother JIM KIDDER, Florida State's original Mascot, "Savage Sam", graduated with honors in Criminology. He is currently working towards a second degree in accounting.


