
CHAPTER TRADITIONS

The **PIKE** House is a hub of fellowship for the brothers, whether it's a pickup game after dinner or a spin around the campus on the firetruck.




Every fall, Florida State's top sororities convene for a lawn party and painting session at the **PIKE** House, each hoping to claim a prime spot to display their coat-of-arms.










PIKE Brothers **JOHN McLEAN** (86) and **BRIAN McCRARY** (43) take a breather and compare defensive notes at Notre Dame.

This 40-yard clutch reception by **PHIL WILLIAMS** against Nebraska set the stage for the Seminoles' 17-14 victory in 1980. As a senior in 1981, Phil averaged nearly 20 yards per catch, and *TRIBE Magazine* called him the team's "big play man". Twice named Scholastic All-American, Phil graduated with 3.8 GPA in accounting, and was recruited into Coopers & Lybrand, a "Big 8" accounting firm.







The 1982 PIKE Soccer Team finished the regular season undefeated and went on to win the All-Fraternity Championship.


Pi Beta Phi Arrow man **JIM PARSONS** was a walk-on linebacker for the Seminoles and served TTKA as kitchen manager.
