



'The Drive' puts Seminoles into bowl picture

TEMPE, Ariz. — You like palpitations? You enjoy the feeling of your heart beating up around your eyeballs? Does the prospect of experiencing utter hopelessness one moment, then ecstasy the next appeal to you?

Then, folks, Saturday night's Duel in the Desert between Florida State and Arizona State was made for you.

Florida State won it 29-26 when substitute quarterback Bob Davis found flanker Jesse Hester on the right end of a 10-yard scoring pass with just six seconds left in the take-

down-prisoners shootout at Sun Devil Stadium.

The game was a furious back-and-forth exercise that saw the lead change hands six times — four times in the final quarter. It was college football at its finest.

The pass to Hester climaxed a series of plays that, given time, will come to be known in FSU annals as simply *The Drive*. There were about a thousand Florida State fans who made the trip. By the time the story is told and retold, there will be at least a hundred-thousand more who will say they were there.








