FSU HOMECOMING *CHIEF!*



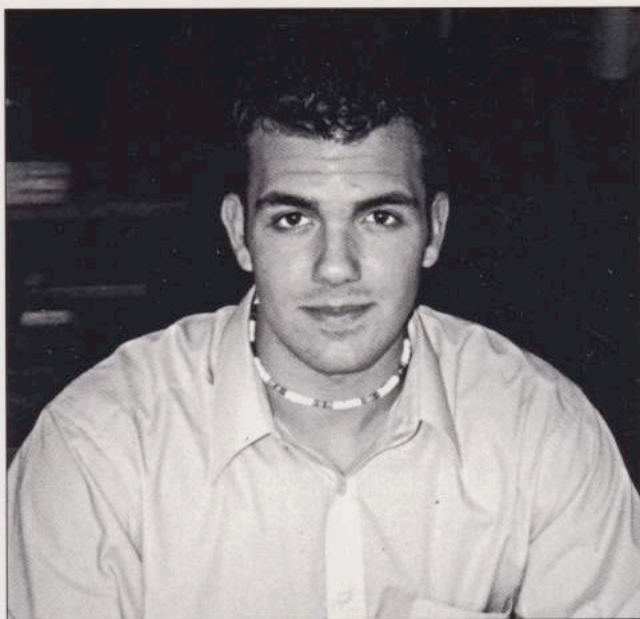

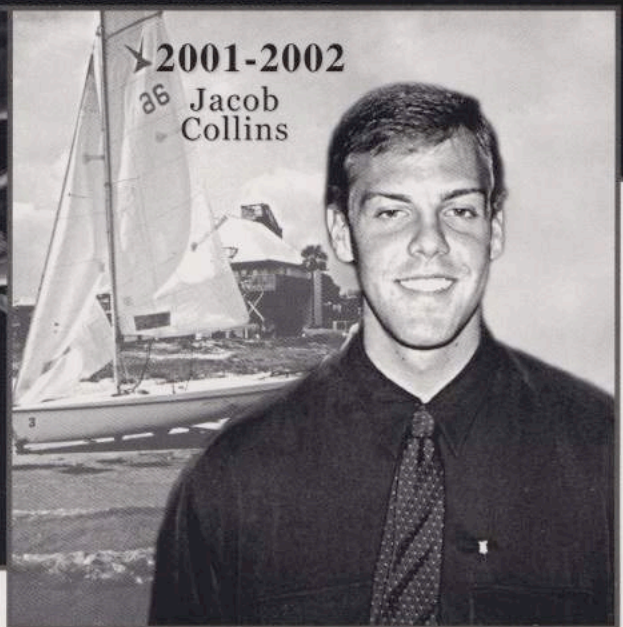
Greg Gorski

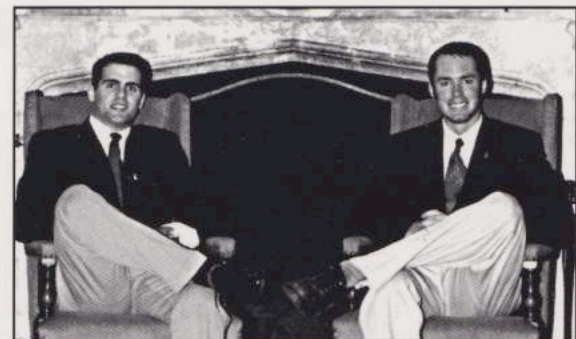

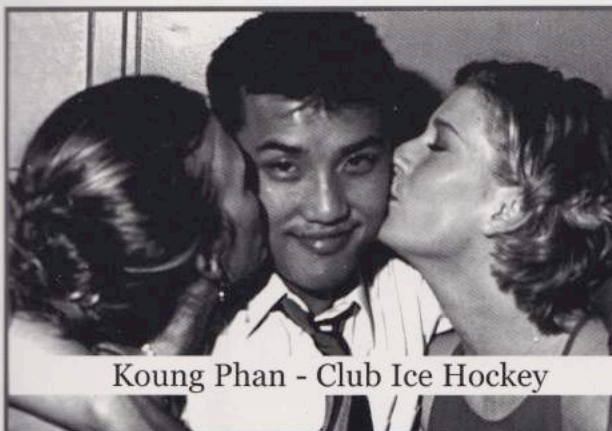

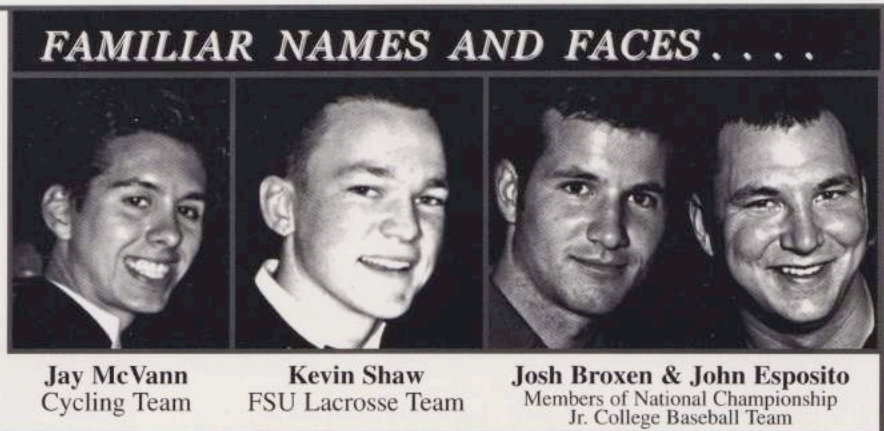


Chris Koch

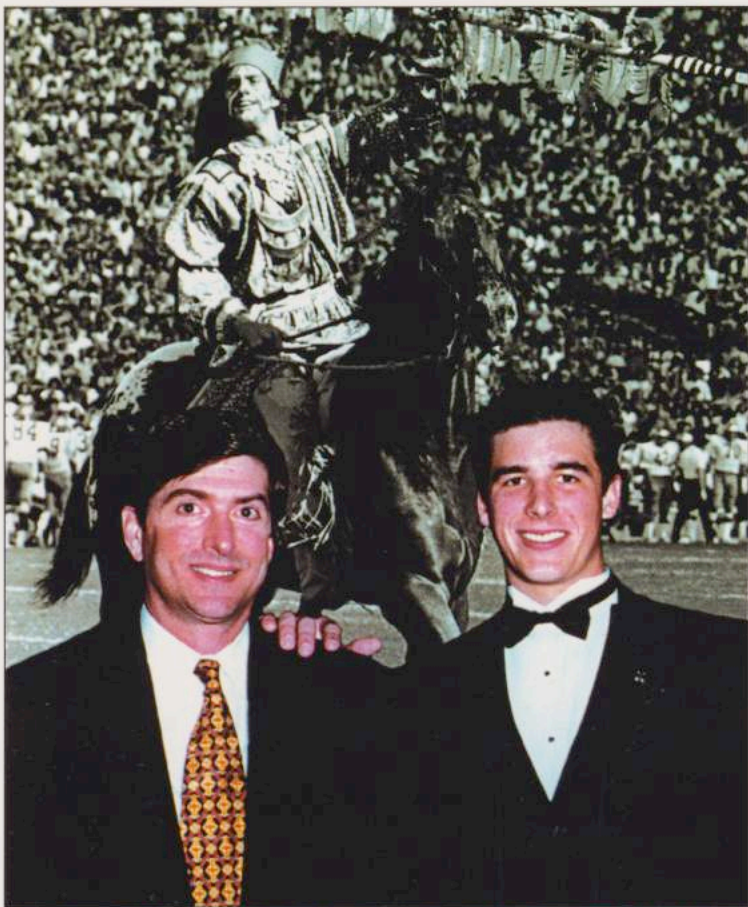

The First Osceola

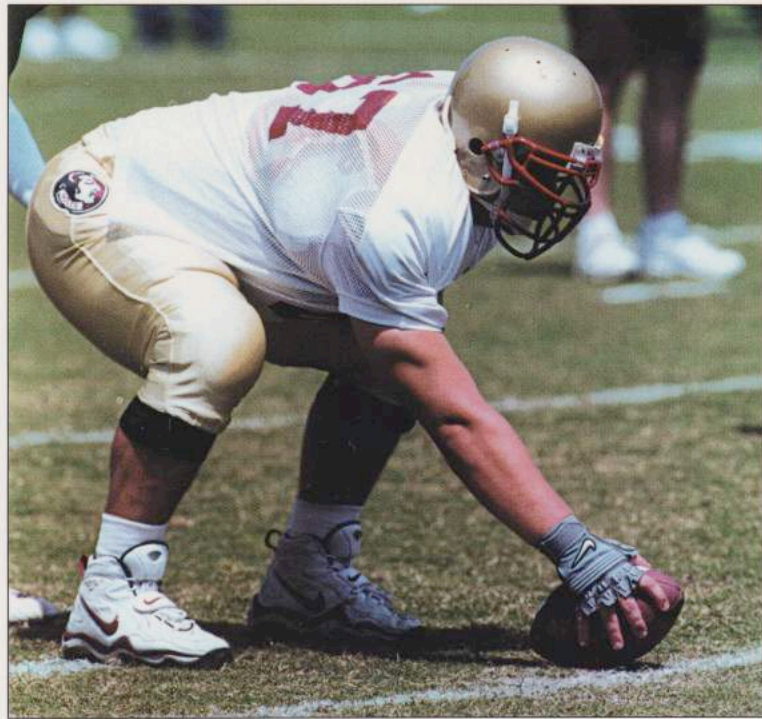

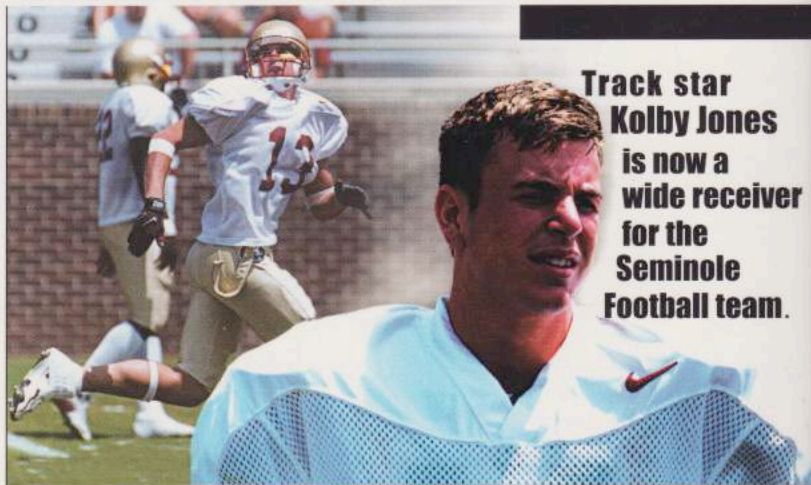
FLORIDA STATE'S TOP MALE SCHOLAR-ATHLETE

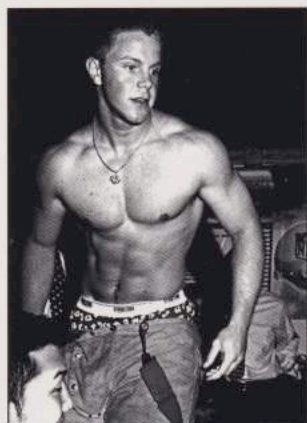
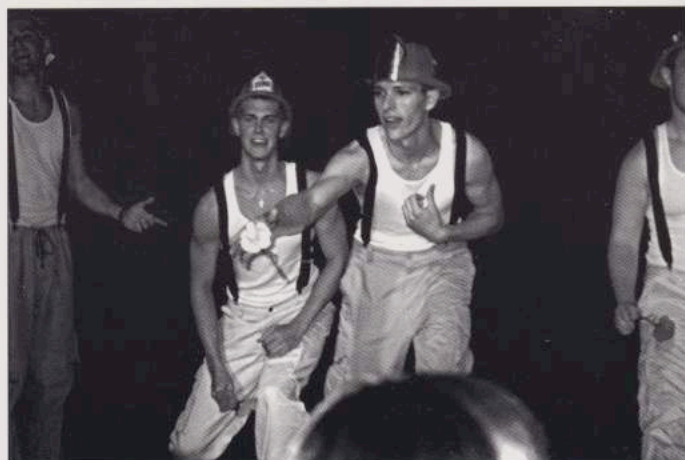


THE PIKE FIRE TRUCK

Our MALE AUCTION raised over \$2,700 in one night.



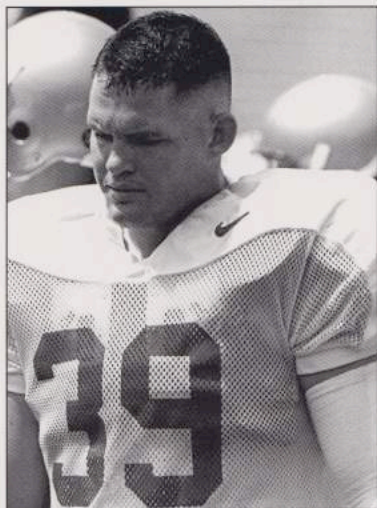
