DOMINATE VARSITY TEAMS

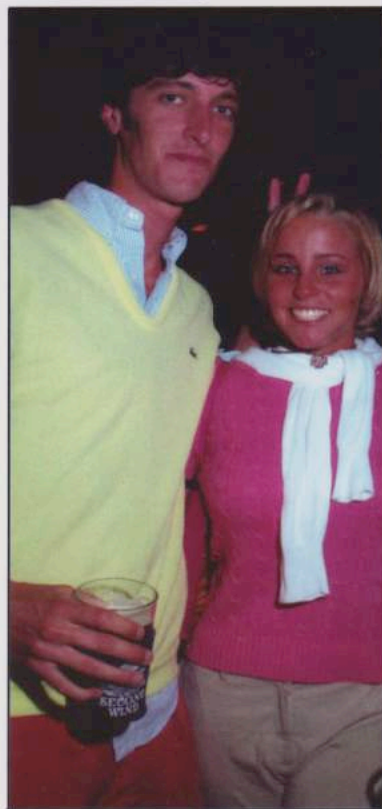
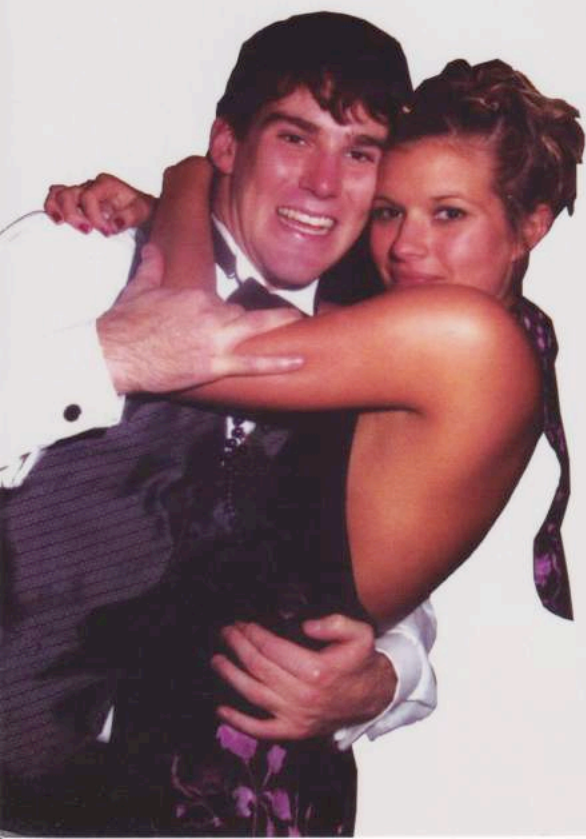

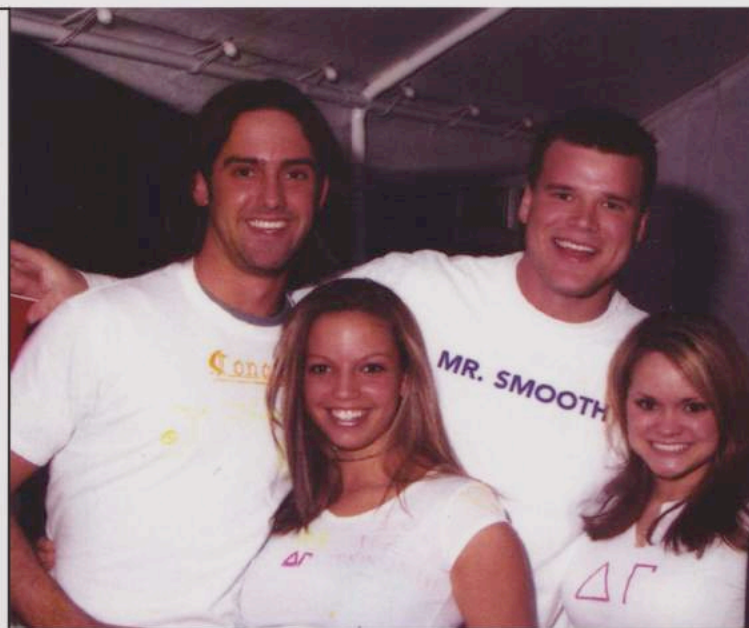
GOOD CITIZENS

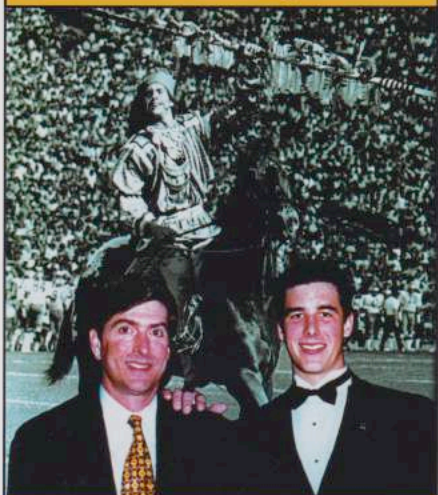
Scott Hundley

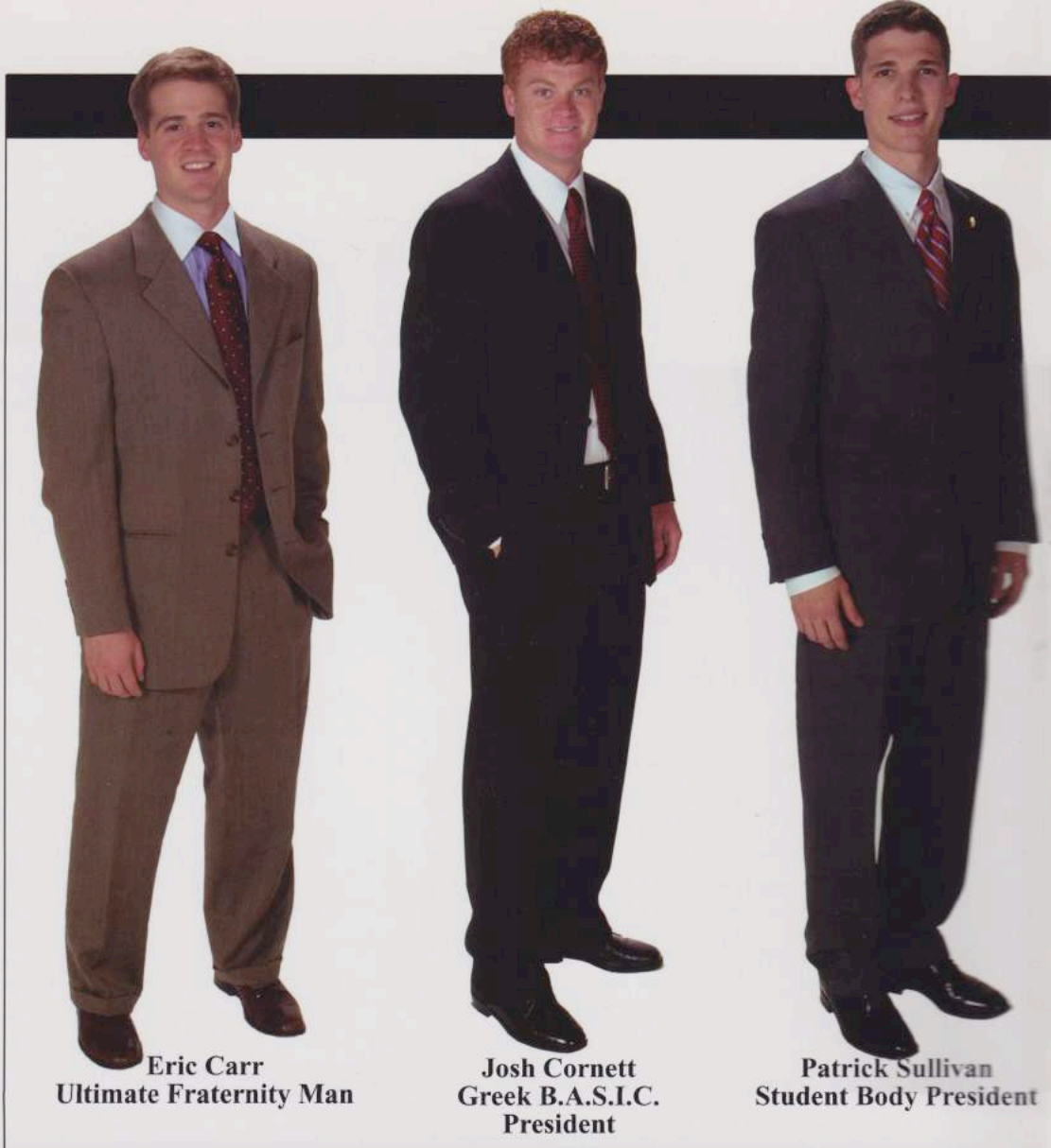
Ken Winard

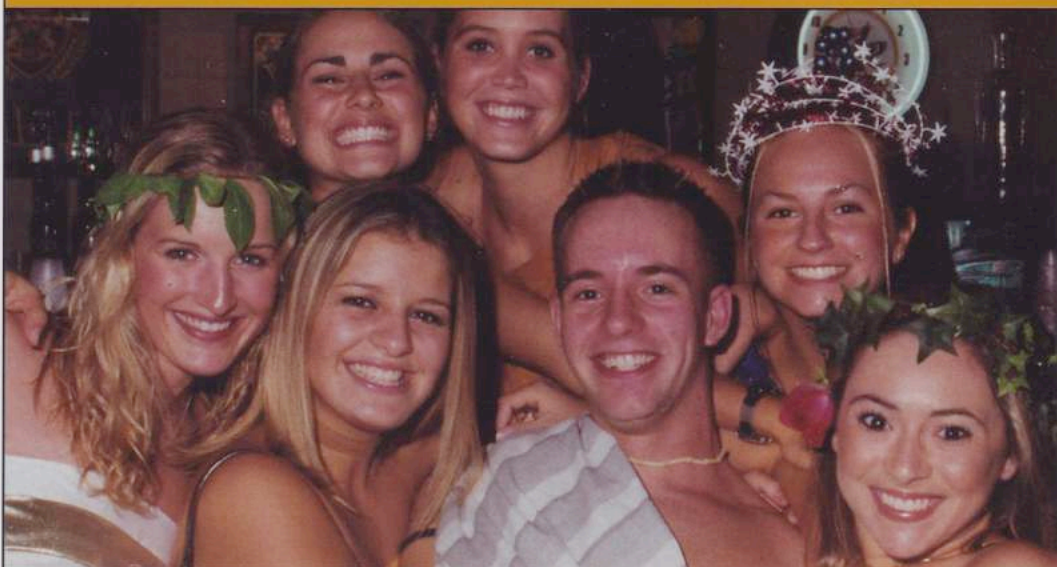

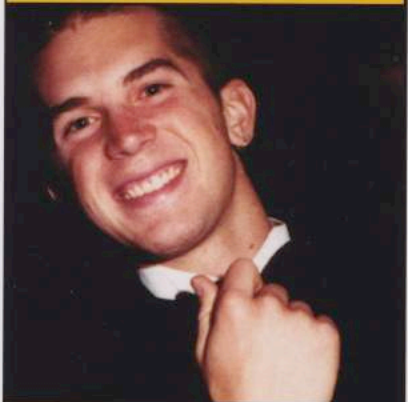

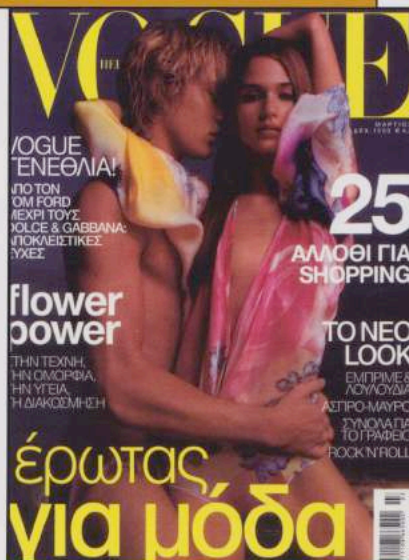
Greg Gorski

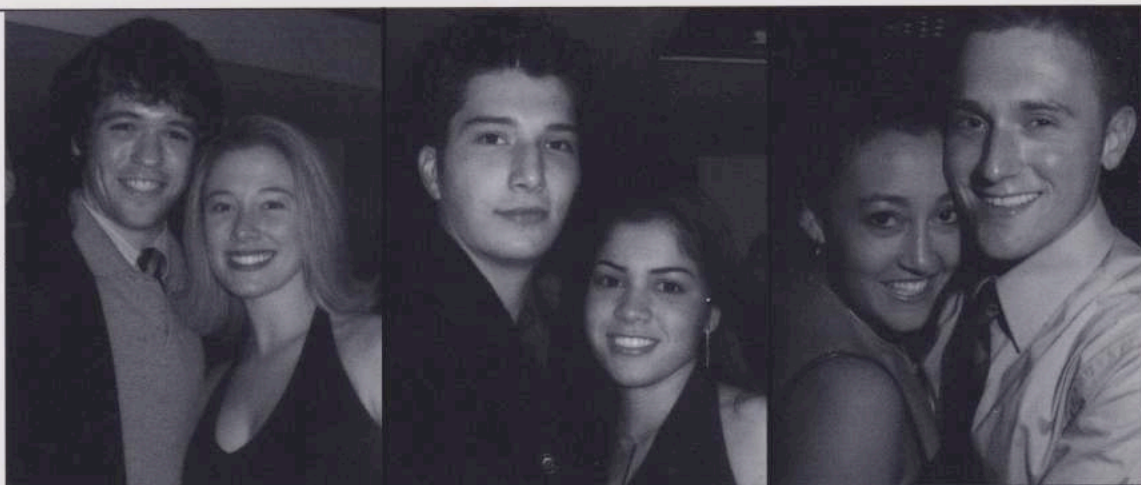

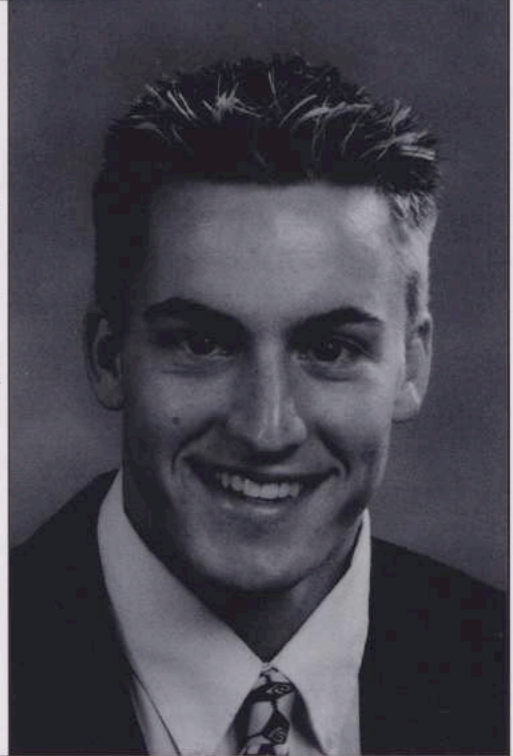


"Ultimate Fraternity Man"

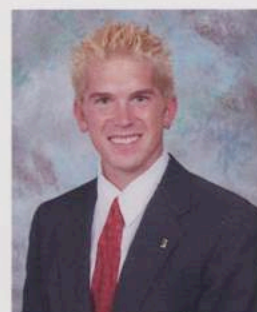

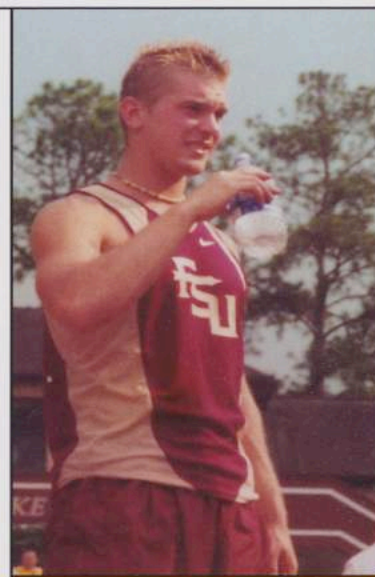

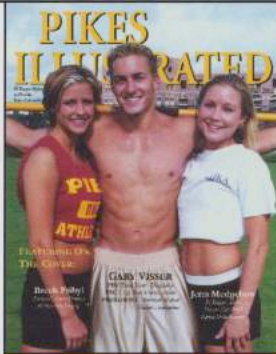
THE PI KAPPA ALPHA ATHLETIC TRADITION

Come by the Pike house during rush, and shake hands with these outstanding men.



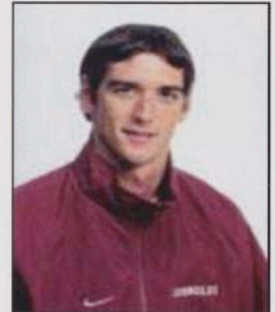
