

## PIKES DOMINATE VARSITY TEAMS





## GOOD CITIZENS




# Every Endeavor


### THE PI KAPPA ALPHA ATHLETIC TRADITION

Ever since the crisp October night in 1947 when Ken Maclean caught the first completed pass in Seminole football history, Pi Kappa Alpha has been the name most closely associated with varsity & club athletics at Florida State. Ken MacLean founded the Pike Chapter here at FSU when he was a student, and we are proud of the fact that so many of Florida State's finest athletes choose to become Pikes.

Since our Chapter's founding Pi Kappa Alpha has produced more than a dozen All-Americans in football, basketball, baseball, track, swimming and golf. Many more Pikes have won All-Conference honors, and still more have been named to the ACC Academic Honor Rolls. In fact, many of our Chapter leaders have come from the ranks of both Varsity and Club athletic teams.

**It is tradition that Pi Kappa Alpha boasts more varsity athletes than all the other fraternities combined!**





Pre-season magazines call Adam "one of the top inside-outside forwards in the Atlantic Coast Conference" and "one of the top defensive forwards in the ACC." Going into his senior season in 2005, he is the Seminoles' leading career rebounder (335 rebounds/3.7 rpg), and second leading returning scorer (429 points/4.7ppg). This season he led the Seminoles in rebounding with a career high 5.4 rebounds per game.
