and his exceptional leadership qualities.






To the right, Joe "Tweeder"






Every Endeavor


THEPIKAPPAALPHA ATHLETIC TRADITION

Ever since the crisp October night in 1947 when Ken Maclean caught the first completed pass in Seminole football history, Pi Kappa Alpha has been the name most closely associated with varsity & club athletics at Florida State. Ken MacLean founded the Pike Chapter here at FSU when he was a student, and we are proud of the fact that so many of Florida State's finest athletes choose to become Pikes.

Since our Chapter's founding Pi Kappa Alpha has produced more than a dozen All-Americans in football, basketball, baseball, track, swimming and golf. Many more Pikes have won All-Conference honors, and still more have been named to the ACC Academic Honor Rolls. In fact, many of our Chapter leaders have come from the ranks of both Varsity and Club athletic teams.

It is tradition that Pi Kappa Alpha boasts more varsity athletes than all the other fraternities combined!


