Pike Football came out on top during the 2006 Fall season. They played and defeated the best teams across the campus of Florida State wining the All Campus Football Championship.



Head Baseball Coach




Veteran end #82 D.J. Norris helps anchor the defensive line.




Tight End Sean Compton snags a pass. Compton was named to the All-ACC Academic Honor roll.




Big fullback Joe Surratt scored seven touchdowns for the Seminoles in 2006, this one against the Florida Gators.
