PIKES Dominate Varsity and Club Sports










EXCELLENCE IN



Sophomore middle linebacker Recardo Wright was voted Most Improved Linebacker in spring drills.




Veteran defensive end **D.J. Norris** was sidelined by injuries and now helps coach the 'Noles.


