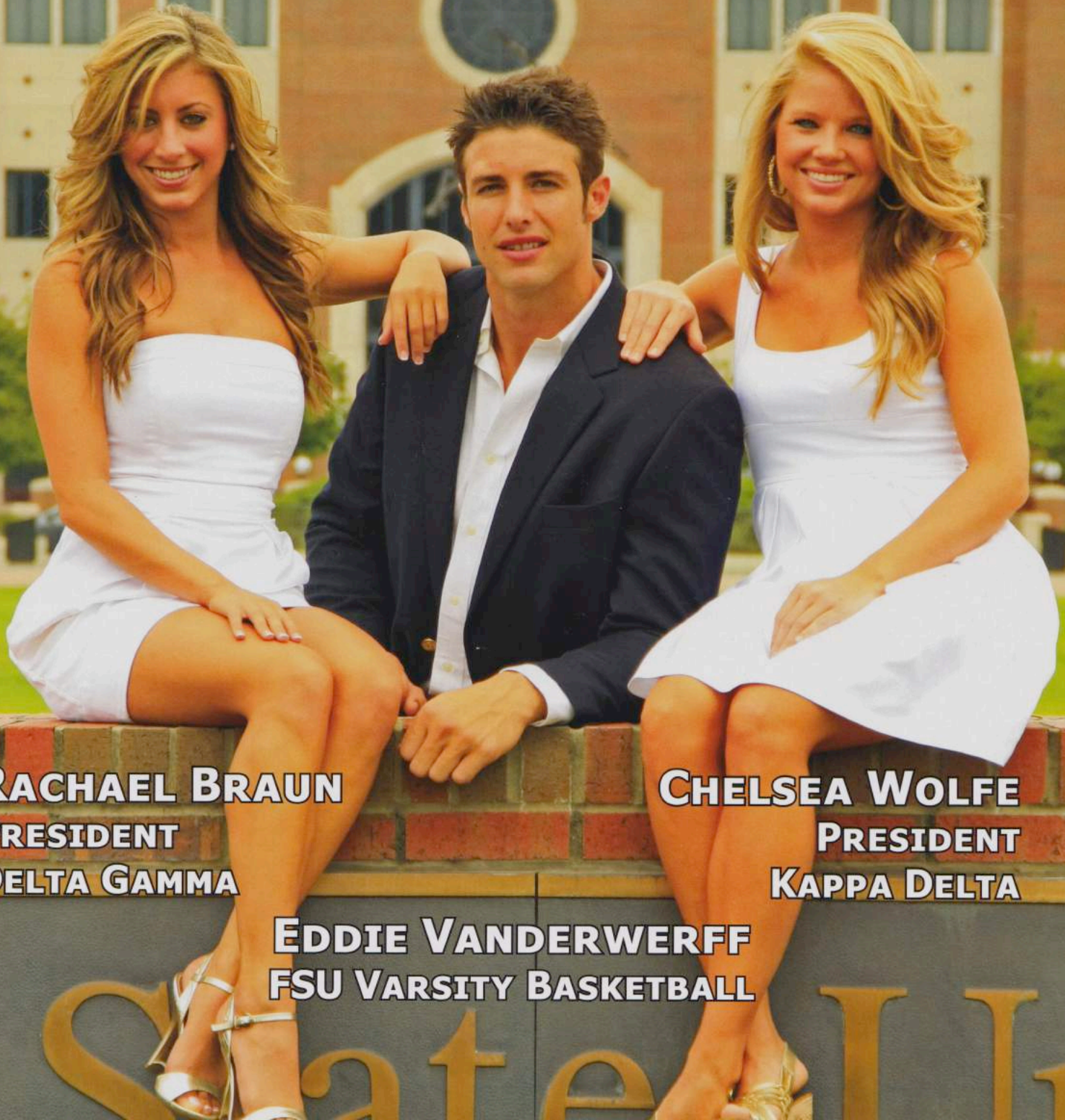

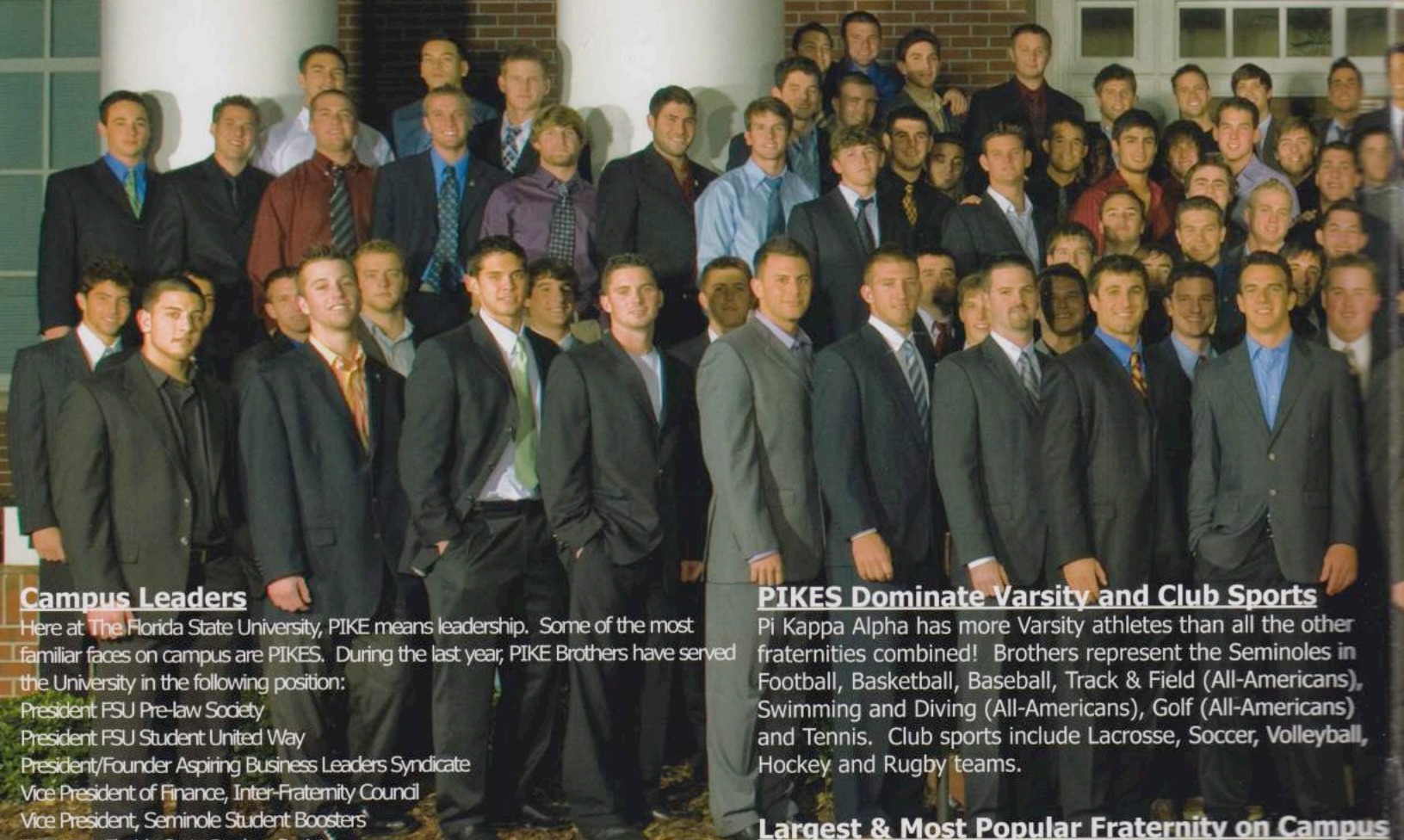

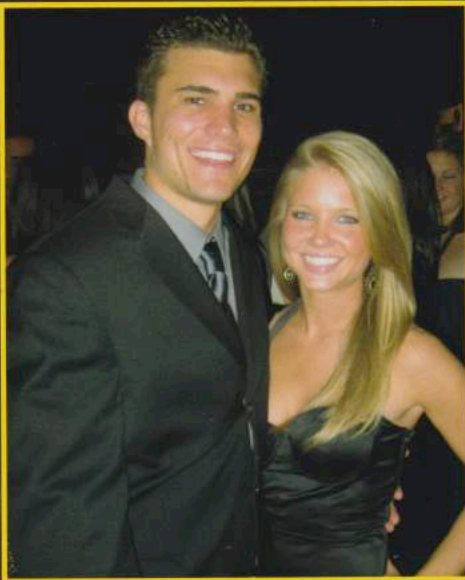
Pi Kappa Alpha won the Overall IM Championship again for the seventh time in nine years. PIKE dominated in the following sports:

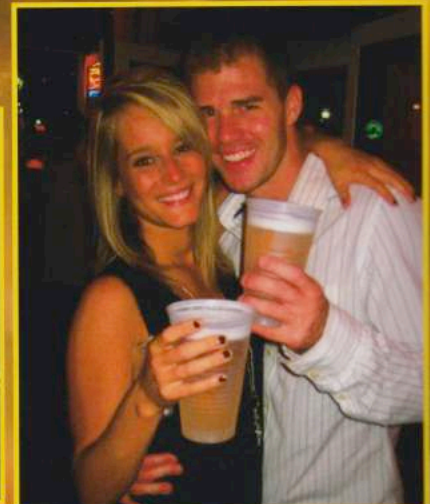
Good Citizens

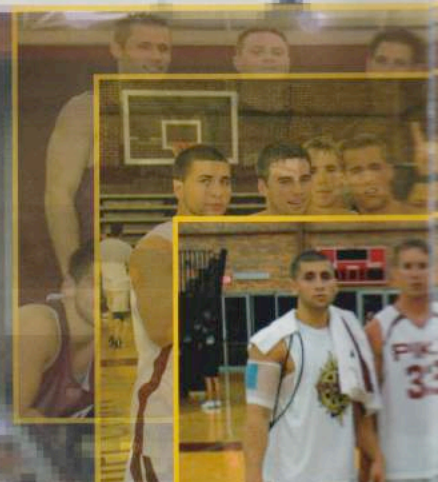

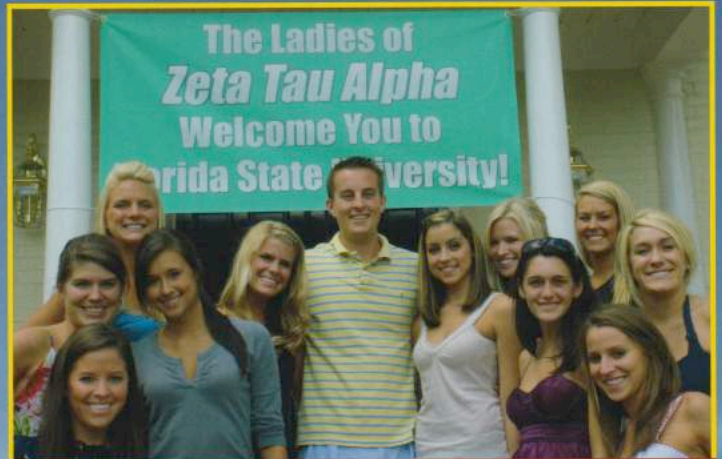

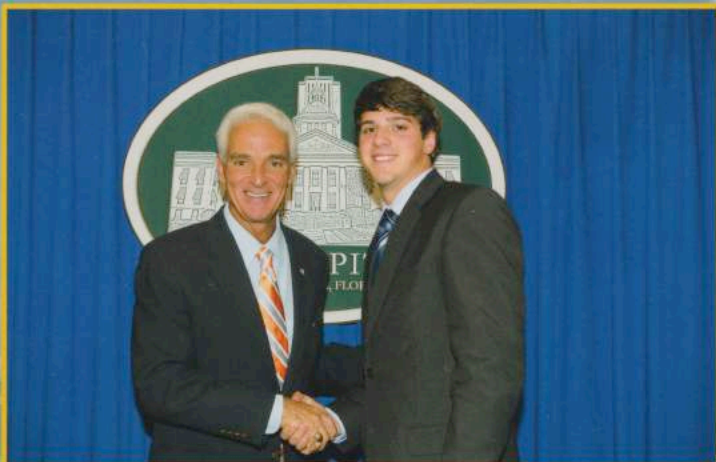
EVERY ENDEAVOR

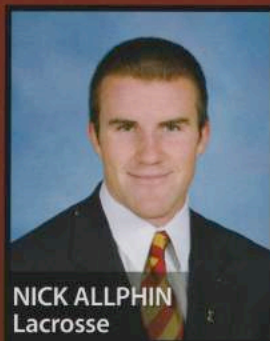


FLORIDA STATE FOOTBALL
