


## Largest & Most Popular Fraternity on Campus




## SOCIAL FUNCTIONS



**Jesse Vance '80:** President of North American On-Site, LLC. He is in charge of Financial, Sales and Operations. NAOS currently operates in Canada and the U.S. His sons, Charles '05 and Jake '08 are also alumni.



**Alan Winslette '77:** COO of Laser Shot, Inc. His Texas-based firm is a global leader in firearm and force-option training for military and law enforcement.



**Mark Gambil '81:** Vice President of Dell, Inc. His son is considering Florida State.



**Ken MacLean '44 (University of Florida):** As a transfer, Maclean Founded the FSU Pike chapter, and then caught the first pass in Seminole football history on October 18th, 1947.


