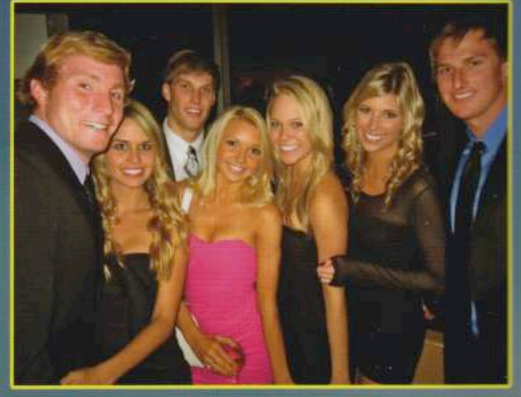
Top PIKE Chapter in the Nation

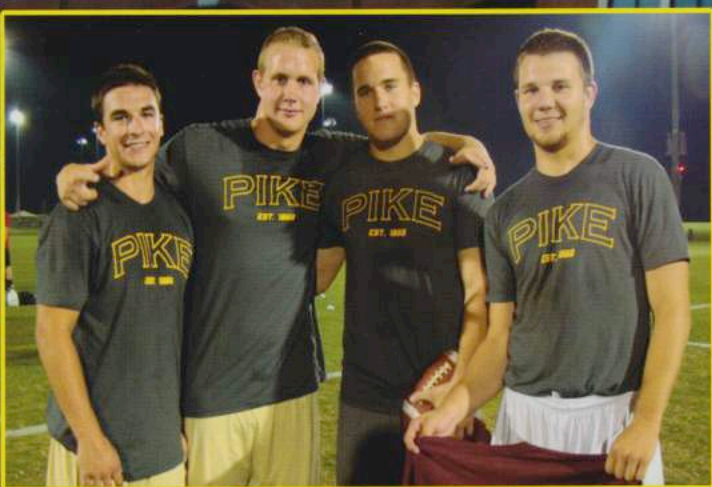
