


7v7 Flag Football All-Campus Champions




Colin Newton on his revolutionary skateboard-like invention, SurfSkate.




Nick Moody returns a Hurricane fumble 36 yards to the Miami one yard line

Jesse Vance '80: President of North American On-Site, LLC. He is in charge of Financial, Sales and Operations. NAOS currently operates in Canada and the U.S. His sons, Charles '05 and Jake '08 are also alumni.

force-option training for military and law enforcement.







