Florida State PIKES host our own philanthropies throughout The year including Christmas For The Kids, Best Jugs On Campus, and the PowderPIKE tournament.










































SOCIAL FUNCTIONS






ONCE A PIKE... III



Mike Martin: College Baseball Hall of Fame; Head Coach at FSU for more than 30 years. Coach Martin's brother Baine Martin '58 was also a Pike at North Carolina State.



Doug Russell: A legistative lobbyist in Tallahassee, FL Doug serves as the current chapter advisor for PIKE's Delta Lambda Chapter. His son, Tyler '10 is a active Brother.

David Rancourt '84: Founding partner of Southern Strategy Group, the largest lobbying firm in the southeast. Rancourt has made gifts to Seminole Boosters totaling nearly \$4 million. David served as President of Pi Kappa Alpha


