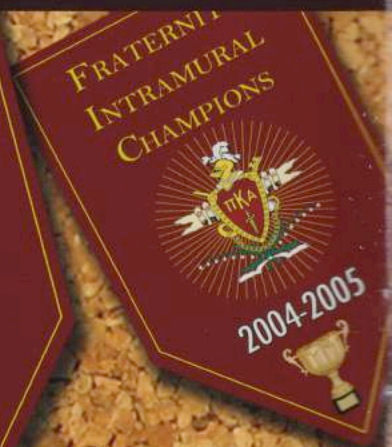
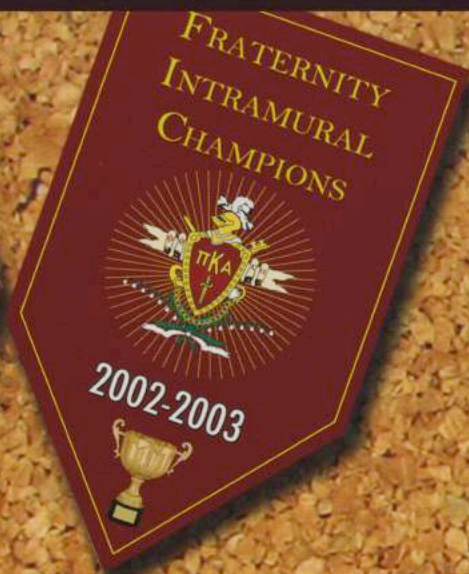

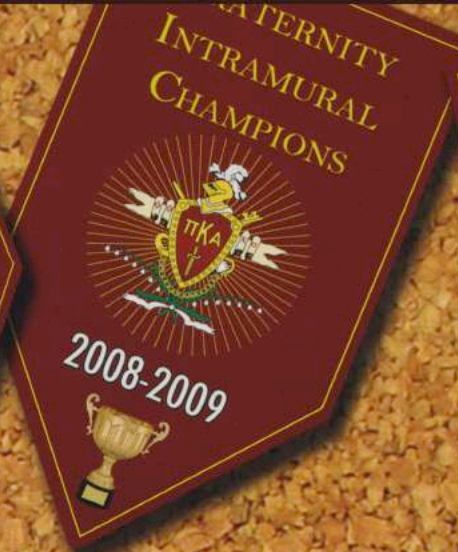

It was only one spring practice. And he knows things will go back to normal when the Florida State football team returns to action on Monday. But considering where he was just one year ago — buried at the bottom of a four-man logjam on the quarterback depth chart — Sean Maguire was understandably excited about the opportunity before him Saturday morning. With starting quarterback Jameis Winston playing baseball in Clemson, S.C., Maguire got to take most of the first-team reps with the national champion Seminoles.

The third-year sophomore didn't feel like he was "a little bumpy," but he and head coach Jimbo Fisher both said the experience went pretty well.

"Getting reps with the first-team offense was a huge," Maguire said. "It's been a little bumpy, but it's been a good experience. I wasn't dominant. It wasn't overpowering. It was just masterful."

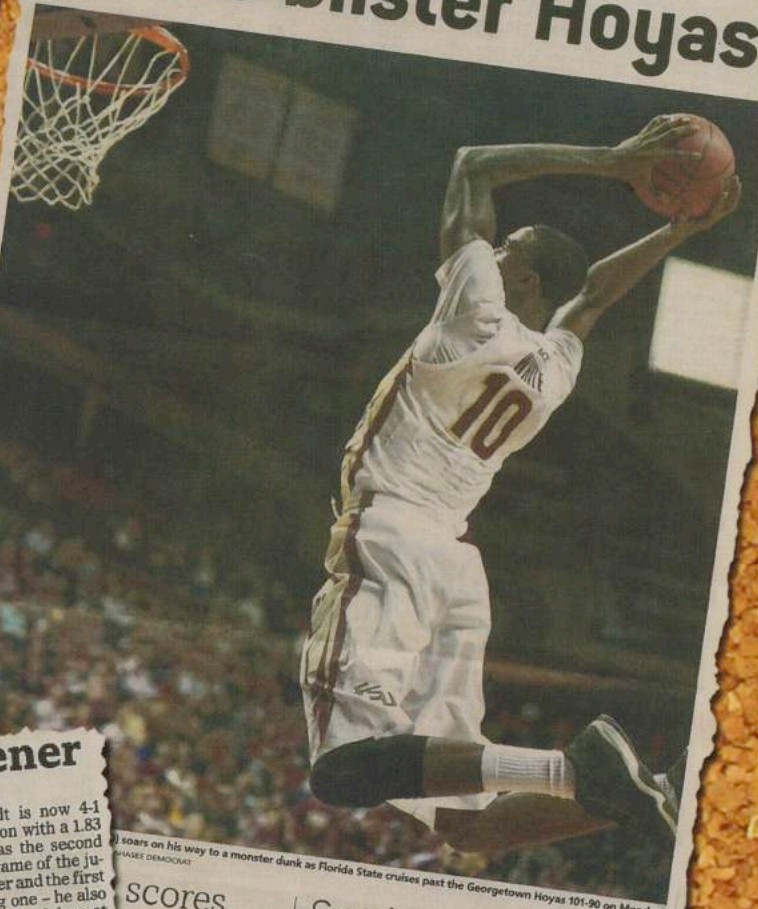

Leibrandt shines in opener

Junior lefty throws second career complete game

Clemson's lone run was unearned. "I didn't feel like I had my best off-speed stuff," Leibbrandt said. "But I felt like I made enough pitches, got enough weak contact and kept them off-balance just enough. I tried that throughout the whole game and it worked."

Did it ever. The Tigers, who had 11 hits and six runs off Luke Weaver on Friday night, managed just four hits in the game — and one was an infield single. Leibbrandt struck out just one, but Clemson's hitters were flummoxed all afternoon by the veteran

lefty. Leibbrandt is now 4-1 on the season with a 1.83 ERA. It was the second complete game of the junior's career and the first nine-inning one — he also had one in a 2-0 loss at Virginia a season ago in which he went eight innings.

"He changes eye levels so well," FSU head coach Mike Martin said. "He'll throw the ball up in the zone, down in the zone, away in. He is just very difficult to get comfortable in there against. ... He was in complete control of that ball."
