

THE PIKE HOUSE AT FLORIDA STATE!

Designed by the award-winning architectural firm of Elliott Marshall Innes, Pi Kappa Alpha's home was built by Chapter Alumni in 2005. With more than 40,000 square feet under one roof, this is the largest fraternity house in America. In addition, the 7,000 square foot enclosed courtyard is an artificial-turf playground for the Chapter Brothers and their guests. Game tailgates are unrivaled at the Pike House. The house features all private rooms and bathrooms plus connecting suites with full kitchens for every two Brothers. Other amenities include ample parking and recreation facilities.

Pike at Florida State is the largest chapter of any fraternity on any campus in the State of Florida.

Socially, Pike is unrivaled at FSU. In the last two years, individual Brothers have been named Man of the Year of prominent sororities like Kappa Delta, Delta Gamma, Tri-Delta, Alpha Delta Pi and Zeta Tau Alpha.

Pike is the defending Overall Intramural Sports Champion, and has won the trophy more than any other fraternity since 2000.

Leadership is the signature of Pi Kappa Alpha at FSU. Six of the last 14 Student Body Presidents are Pikes. In 2017-18 Pikes served as Student Body President, Student Senate President, Student Body Treasurer, Chief Osceola, President of the United Nations Association of FSU, President and Vice President of Uplifting Athletes, Vice President of the Student Athlete Advisory Council, and Executive Vice President of the Interfraternity Council.

Pike is the only IFC fraternity ever to produce a Rhodes Scholar (Dr. Joe O'Shea). Individual Brothers earned recognition in the FSU Honors College, Garnet & Gold Leadership Society, ODK Leadership Honorary, Order of Omega, Dean's List, President's List, FSU Service Scholars, Presidential Scholars and more.

More Seminole varsity athletes join Pike than all the other fraternities combined. In 2017-18, 35 Pike Brothers competed for the Garnet & Gold on the gridiron, the court, the diamond and the track. In 2018, individual Pikes were named All-American in football, track and baseball. Nine more Pike Brothers competed for FSU Club Sports teams.

The FSU Pike Alumni Association is the largest and most active among all fraternities. More than 2,600 initiate names decorate the long and illustrious history of this legendary fraternity chapter.










