Pike added the Soccer trophy to previous Championships won this year in Swimming and 3x3 Basketball.



Major kudos to brother Joe "Hooter"
Feheley, Delta Lambda's Chapter Advisor,
who's clearly knocking it out of the park while
pursuing his MBA at Florida State. Joe was
just accepted into Beta Gamma Sigma
International Honor Society. Membership in
"BGS" is the highest recognition a business
student anywhere in the world can receive for
studies in a business program.

For those who may not be aware of his background, "Hooter" (his fighter pilot call sign) is a Lt. Col. in the U.S. Air Force, where

he has served as an F-16 pilot. His is a terrific story of patriotism and personal drive, one in which we can all take pride.

Following the terror attacks of 9/11, Joe left his lucrative business as a General Contractor to join the Air Force, with the stipulation that they would teach him how to fly jets so he could take the fight directly to Osama and his buddies throughout the region. Over his 15+ years of distinguished service, brother Hooter was deployed several times in Iraqi combat zones, as well as Korea during a sensitive period of Chinese aggression, and most recently in the United Arab Emirates, where he trained local pilots to fly the F-16, so they could hunt bad guys on their own!

Now back stateside, Hooter's checking off three goals at once: (1) pursuing his Master's Degree at Florida State, (2) serving as Delta Lambda's chapter advisor, and (3) sharing both experiences with his son, Sean, an undergraduate brother in Delta Lambda! That's a heck of a trifecta! (Daughter Devin is a Nole, too, by the way!) As a bonus, he's also helping the Chapter's overall GPA!

Look for Joe this Fall during football season and introduce yourself. Take a moment to thank him for his service, both to America and Delta Lambda. You'll never meet a

nicer guy, a more patriotic American or a more loyal brother!
