Our April 3, Alumni/Chapter Leaders Luncheon was well attended. The gathering included five undergraduate collared officers plus a usual number of advisors and a few special guests. Chapter Advisors John Peacock '01 and Scottie Howell '06 hosted along with Ed Barnes '71, Charlie Barnes '65, Chris Dietz '87, Bob Hall '49, Bill Lickson '81, David Markowski '79, Bob McKnight '62, Jeff Moore '81 (and his son Michael), Doug Tatum '77, and Dr. Ken Winnard '01. Jimmy Keen '73 was not available to present a report on the renovation project due to teaching a course, but House Manager Garrett Sargeant '16 reported that the roof is finished and construction on the new rooms is underway.

Undergraduate officers reported that Delta Lambda is leading in points for the IM Trophy. "Delta Tau Delta is our biggest competitor in intramurals". If Pike wins this year, Delta Lambda will have won the Overall Trophy more times than all the other fraternities combined since 2000.

They also reported that Pike won the campus-wide "Line Dance" fundraising competition. This achievement plus Pike's efforts in Dance Marathon benefitting the FSU College of Medicine resulted in Delta Lambda accounting for \$130,000 in charitable philanthropy in 2019.

Marvin Wilson and Cory Durden were recruited to Florida State as Five-Star and Four-Star defensive tackles respectively. Sportswriter Curt Weller says, "Wilson broke out in 2018 with 42 tackles, and he's working to take the next step as FSU's most experienced defensive tackle...Wilson will be a constant force on the d-line this fall."

Weller says "Durden made the most of his playing time in 2018, with 22 tackles including six for loss and is expected to start opposite Wilson." "Marv is like my brother," Durden says. And they are in fact Brothers, in Pi Kappa Alpha.

The Golden Spikes Award is the college baseball equivalent of the Heisman Trophy. Mike Fuentes '78 was awarded the honor after becoming the all-time leading homerun hitter in college baseball history in 1981.


