

FSU Pikes Delta Lambda Newsletter - February, 2018



The Oak Tree, long a symbol of our Fraternity. This image was sketched by Founder William Alexander, 65 years after he designed the original Shield & Diamond badge in 1868. He wrote in 1933, "The spreading oak upon which we look today with wonder and pride could never have grown from the seed of any weed. Its character proves that it was a genuine acorn which was planted at the University of Virginia more than half a century ago."

Alexander was the youngest of the six Founders, and he lived the longest. He died at the age of 90 in 1937. For 65 years he served as Secretary (CEO) of The Equitable Life Insurance Company in New York City. During the time of his leadership The Equitable became the richest privately held financial institution in America in the late 19th and early 20th Centuries.

Upon his death, autographed photos of his fellow Pi Kappa Alpha Founders were discovered in his desk, now on display at Pike Memorial Headquarters in Memphis.

Pi Kappa Alpha's Sesquicentennial Celebration Convention will take place in Richmond, July 25-29, 2018.

We are saddened to report the death of one of our Charter Members of the Old Guard. Frankie Strickland, mother of Gene Strickland '81, was among the dozen Charter Members 36 years ago (1982). She remains the only woman ever to be a member of the Old Guard. Please read more at the end of this newsletter under Ad Astra.

The Current State of Delta Lambda Chapter

Note that Delta Lambda Chapter is not in any trouble, either with the FSU Administration or with Pike National. In fact, Pike National has been very supportive. Our chapter is very well led, but the burden on our chapters' leaders now is great.

The Greek System is still suspended except for a restricted rush and University-mandated 'service projects'. No social events are permitted, and there is the announced imposition of a ruinous \$1 million annual 'Greek Tax' exclusively on FSU IFC fraternity and Panhellenic sorority members. The annual invoice from FSU to Delta Lambda would be \$33,000 with zero benefits to the chapter in return.

We're told only 13 of the 21 fraternities conducted a spring rush, and the University continues to impose severe restrictions and limitations on the process. However, despite the problems, Delta Lambda successfully sought out the best men. Here are 12 of the 16 spring pledges.



Here is a message from Rush Chairman Dalton Herrity '15, seated in front:

"Just wanted to give our alumni a quick report on rush week. Even with the recent suspension and the current standing of Greek Life, we still had a very successful rush. As of yesterday night, I've given bids to 16 guys throughout the three days, 4 of which are varsity athletes. I wanted to be selective with this new Spring pledge class with everything that's going on and I'm confident that our rush team picked the right guys. Looking forward to a great semester, and thank you Alumni for all your help."








Dr. Gary Visser '01 was named Florida State's top Male Scholar-Athlete for two years in a row. He was President of the American Medical Students Association,







Frankie Harrison Strickland 1934-2018
Charter Member of The Old Guard of Delta
Lambda

She was a great campus beauty and an original member of the famous Florida State Flying High Circus in the early 1950s.




They called her "Fabulous Frankie", a name to which she did not object. Frankie and her husband 'Strick' Strickland were also among the original Golden Chiefs when Bobby Bowden arrived in 1976.

She was everywhere and did everything.
She was elected to the Board of the FSU
Foundation, the Seminole Boosters Board,
and the FSU Alumni Association Board, and
she was a founding member of the
University Center Club. And through sheer

force of will, persistence and probably intimidation, somehow Frankie was able to convince the States of Georgia and Florida to allow students from South Georgia to attend Florida State without having to pay out-of-state tuition.

All of us who came within her orbit – friends, Seminoles, pets, Pikes, children and grandchildren – were well aware of the powerful gravitational force of her personality.

She was fiercely loyal to Kappa Delta, and proud of her KD granddaughter Shanna (Derby). Most especially she was proud of her Pike son Gene Strickland '81, the 1985 'KD Man'. Garland Gould '81 was the 1984 'KD Man' and Allyn Hanson '81 (Chapter Eternal) was the 1983 'KD Man', so KD Man was pretty much a Pike prerogative.



When the Old Guard of Delta Lambda was initially organized in 1982, Frankie Strickland was among the first to contribute as a Charter Member. She remains the only woman to ever enjoy membership in the Old Guard.

No, Frankie never knelt with us at the Altar of Pi Kappa Alpha, but there has never been another pure heart more representative of the true spirit of Phi Phi Kappa Alpha than Frankie Strickland.

Sweet girl. Rest in Peace.
