March 6, 2016: "The Chapter Updates and Officers' Reports were Inspirational." On the first Wednesday of every month, five of the top Chapter officers meet for lunch with local alumni who perform various advisory roles with the Chapter. Any and all alumni are welcome. The bill for the five undergrads' meals is pro-rated among the attending alumni.

This March 6th, eleven current Chapter officers along with two newly initiated pledges attended. SMC Wyatt Rancourt said, "The news is good right now, and the officers are so eager to tell their stories, that we brought a larger number. Also, this month we have arranged for the Chapter to pay for all of us undergrads as well as all the attending alumni. Please let this be our treat."

Chuck Cottrell '80 was visiting from Melbourne. Chuck writes, "I can't say enough how impressed I am with the endeavors and accomplishments of the chapter." He also wrote a personal note to SMC Rancourt saying, "It was classy that you said you were blessed with good Brothers around you...but many kudos to you individually my friend. You should be very proud of the great job you're doing as President."

A few of the highlights from the Chapter Officers' reports:

- ...(Wyatt Rancourt '16) "This is the best overall right now since I've been here."
- ...IVP Jake Garber '16 reported a fun trip by 50 Pike undergrads to attend a Tampa Bay Lightening game. He also delighted everyone with reports of Opening Day of Stickball League, Delta lambda's own exclusive in-house competition.
- ...Dylan Neilander '15 has created a campus-wide Bible Study series to be held at the Pike house. "We are the only fraternity with a Chaplaincy Advisor."
- ...Treasurer Kevin Anderson '16 reported that the Chapter is on solid financial ground.
- ...Excellence Officer Zach Blashinsky '16 said that Pike is an original sponsor and one of only four fraternities involved in hosting the annual campus-wide "Line Dance" philanthropy. "Our goal is to win the competition to raise the most money for charity during Line Dance", he said. Alumni speculated that The Old Guard will pitch in to help. ...Pledge Master Jeremy Wozunk '16 reported that we pledged 21 this spring, and initiated 20. Scott Roix '85, father of Alumni Chairman Max Roix '18 was present at the last two initiations, and has been especially active in encouraging greater Chapter involvement, and a more serious and respectful ceremonial approach in the initiation ceremony. Pledge Class President Michael Reece '19 and Vice President David Joseph '19 each spoke of the emotional impact of the Initiation Ceremony they just experienced.

...Alumni Chairman Max Roix '18 proposed that the Chapter host a golf tournament in concert with the alumni during the weekend of the Miami game next fall.

...External VP Tripp Brown '15 reported that Pike is currently leading in overall points for the Intramural Championship Trophy. Because of the chaos in the fraternity system last year, no overall championship was awarded to any fraternity in 2018. If Pike wins again this year, Delta Lambda will have won the Overall Championship more times since 2001 than all the other fraternities combined. ... House Manager Garrett Sargent '16 updated alumni on progress with repairs to the horrendous damage inflicted on the house by a broken water main over Christmas break. "Seven suites are being completely rebuilt and re-furnished. They will be the nicest rooms in the house."

...Rush Chairman Austin Webb '16 is already reviewing rush recommendations and prospects for the summer and fall. As Rush Chairman, his first class this spring was exceptional.

...Secretary Kyle Finney '17 reported on upcoming social events like "Pike Polo Punch" at the Recess Club overlooking Doak Campbell Stadium, and "Pike Courtyard Day". Also, the Chapter will host a "Dads Day" the weekend of the spring Garnet & Gold Football Game (April 5,6).


...Other creative new Chapter initiatives include a raffle for prizes for those Brothers who do well on exams.





The Pike House is Getting a New \$150,000 Roof!

Thanks (always) to the brilliance, advance planning and leadership of The Legends of Delta Lambda, chaired by **Brent Sembler** '78, your Pike house has undergone nearly a half million dollars in repairs and renovations since January 1st.

Legends Board member Jimmy Keen '73 reports, "By the time the Newsletter is published the roof will be completed FINALLY. I have them cleaning up a few details; during construction they broke some gutters, soffit, etc. The crews will likely be working long days to complete this project."

Keen added, "Replacement of the roof was not due to hurricane damage or the flood from the broken pipe. Replacement was due to the 15-year-old roof I had patched on top and from the attic many times.

Brent and I decided we just had to bite the bullet and replace the roof."



You may not recognize this fellow in costume but he is Brendan Carter '17 who portrayed Chief Osceola through the 2017 season. While many alumni and undergraduates alike contributed their heroic efforts in the wake of the Pike House disaster, Jimmy Keen '73 stressed the importance of including "special kudos" to Brendan Carter. "Brendan arrived

back to the house from holiday a day or two after the terrible water break was discovered," Jimmy says. "He was my SUPER STAR! Every time -and there were many times - I called or texted he was immediately on what I asked him. He was the liaison to help me keep the chapter informed. He was allowed into the construction site and trusted with the master key to the affected rooms to supervise. For me to get the contractors in to do their work to prevent additional damage I had to issue a short time frame for all personal items to be removed from the house. The contract specified that any items left after a specific date would be considered trash. Brendan jumped was the fire who pushed the Brothers and he helped them move to the pods they were issued. Per my request he assigned pods and locks with a key. He kept a perfect ledger."
