The members of Pi Kappa Alpha are committed to the ideal of service to our University and to our community. We have a large chapter with many brothers participating in a wide range of charity fundraising programs and events.



Line Dance: Showcase of the Arts is the largest Greekrun philanthropy at FSU. It is hosted by Pike and three other fraternities. The event consists of a sorority dance competition in which all 17 Panhellenic sororities participate. Based on dance performance and participation in smaller events the week-of, a winner is crowned.

Pike believes in serving the community. That's why we've racked up more than 2,500 combined community service hours this year alone.

Designed by the award-winning architectural firm of Elliott Marshall Innes, Pi Kappa Alpha's home was built by Delta Lambda Chapter alumni in 2005. With more than 40,000 square feet under one roof, it is the largest fraternity house in America. In addition, the 7,000 square foot enclosed courtyard is an artificial-turf playground for Pike Brothers and their guests. Game-day tailgates and 'Courtyard Days' are unrivaled here. The house features all private rooms and bathrooms, plus connecting suites with full kitchens for every two Brothers. Other amenities include ample parking and recreation facilities.

Pike at Florida State is the largest chapter of any fraternity on any campus in the State of Florida.

Social life here is unrivaled. In the last three years, individual Pike Brothers have been named 'Man of the Year' by prominent FSU sororities like Kappa Delta, Delta Gamma, Tri-Delt, Alpha Delta Pi, Zeta Tau Alpha, Sigma Delta Tau and Alpha Phi.

Pike is the current defending Overall Fraternity Intramural Sports Champion, and Pikes have won the trophy more than all the other fraternities combined since 2000.

Campus Leadership is the signature of Pike at Florida State. Six of the last 15 Student Body Presidents are Pike alumni. Pike is the only IFC fraternity at FSU to produce a Rhodes Scholar (Dr. Joseph O'Shea).

Traditionally, more Seminole varsity athletes join Pike than all the other fraternities combined. In 2018-2019, both Varsity Baseball Captains and two of the three Varsity Football Captains are Pikes.

The Pike Alumni Association is the largest and most active among all FSU fraternities. Nearly 3,000 initiate names decorate the long and illustrious history of this legendary fraternity chapter.


BASEBALL AMERICA 2019 COLLEGE PREVIEW COVER FEATURES THREE PIKES!
