MID-YEAR CHAPTER UPDATE

As we plow into 2020, Delta Lambda looks back on a prosperous fall semester. Their big fall house party featured the popular band 'Carnage', fully in compliance with FSUPD and the attendant FSU regulations. Also, four party busses carried 210 Pike Brothers and dates to the chapter's Fall Formal in New Orleans.

Pike won the 2019 All-Greek volleyball championship to go with their All-Greek and All-Campus football championship.

In fall IFC elections, Pike is the only fraternity to win two offices. **David Joseph '19** is Vice President for Judicial Affairs and **Mike Reese '19** is Vice President for

Membership Development. Student Senator **Jonathan Levin '18** will run for Student Body President this spring. If he wins, Jonathan will be the **sixth** Pike Student Body President since 2003.

Defensive tackle **Marvin Wilson '18** and **Kicker Aguayo '16** were two of FSU's three co-captains this fall. Wilson won All-ACC honors, and was also named FSU's MVP Defensive Lineman. He also won the 2019 Monk Bonasorte Award. Defensive tackle **Corey Durden '18** was awarded the 2019 Tough Man Award by FSU. He started all 12 games while battling a shoulder injury.

Senior Tight End **Gabe Nabers '16** was named winner of the 2019 Don Powell Award, and Punter **Tommy Martin '19** was named winner of the 2019 Walk-On Award. Seminole Track athlete (jumps) **Hunter Napier '19** won the FSU Golden Torch Award for academics. Freshman **Ryan Fitzgerald '19** was a USAToday First team All-American kicker in high school who will suit up for the Seminoles for the first time in 2020. Lineman **Landon Dickerson '17** transferred to Alabama where he started 12 Games and won All-SEC honors.

Delta Lambda remains Florida State's largest fraternity, and has been for 20 years since our re-Founding in 2000. Among the many Pikes who deserve MUCH credit for Delta Lambda's current record of success are immediate past SMC **Wyatt Rancourt '16**, our current Chapter Advisors **John Peacock '01** and **Scottie Howell '06**; **Brent Sembler '78** (son, **Logan Sembler '08**), Chairman of Legends of Delta Lambda as well as Legends Board Member **Jimmy Keen '73** (son **Michael Keen '14**) and general contractor **Peter Ford '14**.

Also worthy of note, **Max Roix '18** is now the chapter's Internal Vice President, and his dad **Scott Roix '85** for more than a year now has assumed responsibility for assuring that Initiation Ceremonies follow the proper Ritual. SMC Wyatt Rancourt's father (and past SMC himself) **David Rancourt '84** was an omnipresent figure this year supporting the chapter leadership in every imaginable way. Legacy Dads Founder **Doug Russell '79** (son, **Tyler Russell '10**) advises the chapter on rush and was responsible for inspiring the Delta Lambda to pledge 40+ men in the summer, before fall rush even began.

California-based Venture Capital Firm Founded by Two Delta Lambda Pikes

Corporate partners, and Co-Founders of **Type One Ventures** www.typeone.vc, Tarek and Justin flew from their headquarters in San Francisco to Tallahassee this fall to meet with **Doug Tatum '77** to discuss growth strategy for their company. Tatum is FSU's official 'Entrepreneur -in-Residence' at the Jim Moran Institute of Entrepreneurship, the nation's first stand-alone college of entrepreneurship at a public university. "Justin Walker and I are running an early stage venture capital fund out here in San Francisco. Our portfolio companies are always looking to hire and we've noticed that FSU is underrepresented in the tech ecosystem out here on the west coast. So, we're

working on building a bridge between the business school and this venture ecosystem. We'd like to also like to build a similar bridge with our Fraternity that can help the Delta Lambda guys with internships, experience, exposure, and even jobs after graduation.

While on campus, SMC **Wyatt Rancourt '16** and **Max Roix '18** arranged for Justin and Tarek to meet with a dozen undergraduate Pike Brothers, all enthusiastic budding entrepreneurs. Florida State, and especially Pi Kappa Alpha, seems to produce an inordinately high number of successful young entrepreneurs.

Both men are active and loyal Delta Lambdas. Justin was Tarek's Pike Big Brother. Type One Ventures boasts close to \$1 billion in assets and is aggressively seeking growth. A pleasant surprise on the company's website is the name of **Dr. Avi Assidon '09**, listed as Healthcare Advisor to the company. Avi, of course was a contemporary of theirs in the chapter. He served FSU as Student Body President, and is now a general surgery resident in Palo Alto.

RugSmart, Inc. Co-Founders, **Stephen Cumbest '86** (left, with son **Cole '19**) and **Chris Saliga '86** (right). Stephen Cumbest and Chris Saliga started selling rugs in Atlanta in 1993. As their knowledge of the business grew, so did their inventory, which led to the opening of the store on "Furniture Row" in Norcross, Georgia. RugSmart has quickly become a leader in online area rug retailing, and in the metro Atlanta area, rug shoppers have known RugSmart as the source for affordable, quality rugs for years.

Comments from Brothers

Just before Christmas, two separate Memorial Gifts of \$1,000 each to The Old Guard were received to honor the memories of **James Bobby (J. Bob) Humphries '66** and **Craig Steven Kavka '66**. They are mourned, and their memories cherished by their friends and Brothers from long ago.

Craig Kavka '66 died at age 29 in a tragic house fire in 1976, at his home in Surf City, New Jersey. He owned and operated Craig Realty Company in West Creek. His obituary noted that he was a member of the Pi Kappa Alpha Fraternity, as well as the local Lions Club; Craig was a member of The Elks, and was a communicant in South Plainfield of Our Lady of Czestochowa Church.

J. Bob Humphries '66 passed away in 2005 at the age of 58, from Lou Gehrig's Disease. He left behind his beloved wife Barbara and three daughters. His obituary noted that "he valued his brotherhood in the Pi Kappa Alpha Fraternity." Bob served in the Judge Advocate General Corps overseas during the Vietnam War; he later made his mark as a prominent business and community leader in Tampa. On October 20, 2001, the Florida Bar awarded Bob the Gerald T. Hart Outstanding Tax Attorney of the Year.

Also this December, The Old Guard of Delta Lambda received additional, generous gifts from loyal alumni.

Past SMC **Bobby Jones '72** contributed \$1,000 to maintain his membership in the Bent Sembler Society.

The father-son duo of **Wade Wilcox '86** and **Griffin Wilcox '15** are Old Guard contributors; Wade renewing his commitment, and Griffin joining for the first time in the new year.
