Delta Lambda Chapter Advisor John Peacock '01 Inducted into the Leon High School Football Hall of Fame

Old Leon High School (established 1871) is one of Florida's iconic educational institutions. The Lions' storied football dynasty won their first State Championship in 1937. In 1947, ten former Leon players formed the core of Florida State University's first football team, and the Seminoles' first coach, Ed Williamson, was also a Lion football alumnus.

It was a singular high honor, but not unexpected, when on December 9th, 2021 former Leon star scholar-athlete **John Peacock '01** was inducted into the Leon High Football Hall of Fame. At the formal banquet, three tables were crowded with Pike alumni and undergraduates.

John came to Florida State to play linebacker for the Seminoles in 2001, also the year he pledged Pi Kappa Alpha. At the end of his freshman season, John was named 'Most Valuable Defensive Player on the Scout Team'.

When asked what it was like to play defense for four years under Coach Mickey Andrews, John Jaughed and said it was interesting.

John's last game as a senior was in the January 1st 2005 Gator Bowl victory over West Virginia. He played one season of professional football for the Arena League Titans in 2008, before turning to a career in the insurance industry.

John remained active with Fraternity alumni events, building a reputation as a mentor to the undergraduates. He has been consistently involved in community affairs, serving as President of the Capital City Rotary Club in 2010, and a member of the Board of Directors of the Tallahassee Quarterback Club. John has also travelled overseas on Mission trips for his Church.

In 2019 John accepted the post of Delta Lambda Chapter Advisor. He shared Advisor honors with **Scottie Howell '06** until Scottie relocated last year to New Mexico. However, John and Scottie still work as a team providing oversight and help to the undergraduates, and maintain a positive relationship with the University administration.

John is co-owner of Capital Risk Management in Tallahassee.

Carlos and Jarrod and their beautiful wives Kelly and Amanda were cruising the many glittering wonders of Times Square when they came upon the signboard display for "Jimmy's Corner". The iconic New York nightclub is a Manhattan eatery and bar with a great back-story that appealed to the adventurers.

They sent Jimmy Keen a steady stream of photos taken during their four-day excursion.

[&]quot;Jimmy's Corner" was a family-run operation for fifty years until Covid forced them to close doors. Founder and owner Jimmy Glenn was a Hall of Fame boxing trainer. Then his son, a Harvard lawyer, quit his practice to take over during the crisis just to keep the bar open.

Keen mentored both of these past Presidents and they have all remained close. It was during Jimmy's and Don Pumphrey's legal presentations to the pledges that Carlos began considering law school.

"Carlos was a senior he came to me and asked if I would ask Don Pumphrey '09 to set him up to visit his office for a few days . He was thinking about going through law school. When I asked Don, he said does he own a conservative suit. I said "Of course; he's is a Pike". Don told me to tell Carlos to be at his office at 6:30 AM sharp the following morning. They went to court together and Carlos sat at the defense table with the defendant and Don."

Jimmy said, "I think these stories are very interesting and show the networking and relationships developed while being a Pike Brother. I know my closest Brother circles include men like Carlos Lindo, Jarrod Germano and **Brent Sembler '78**, along with other groups of Brothers. I would have never imagined that I could be part of a better and more valued circle of Pikes."

Jarrod is Senior Vice President of Tech Mahindra Healthcare in Jacksonville. The Jax Business Journal named him one of the "40 Under 40" stars in 2017

Carlos and Amanda are back in Tallahassee where Carlos is Vice President and senior legal counsel for New Directions Behavioral Health.

Both men have expressed continued gratitude to Keen for his role in opening doors of opportunity for them.

He earned his Bachelor of Science Degree in Geology from Florida State University in 1953. While at FSU, he was a member of Pi Kappa Alpha Fraternity, and met his wife Myrtle Helen Simpson at the Sweet Shop on campus. Upon graduation he worked with several oil companies as a field geologist, then he transitioned to a career in real estate and was eventually the President of the Tallahassee Board of REALTORS in 1966. After real estate and a brief stint as a lobbyist with the Florida legislature, he worked for the Department of Environmental Regulation for the State of Florida until he retired after 25 years of service.

George was the life of most parties and had many life-long friends with whom he and the family spent a great deal of time.
