David Lyons '65 and Jeannie

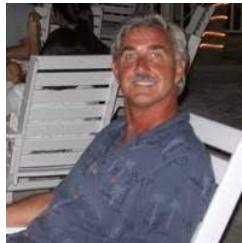

David chaired the 1994 Capital Campaign to renovate the old Wildwood house before National cancelled the colony. David was an original member of the Old Guard when it was first created in 1982. David was also the first individual to endow a Seminole Football Scholarship after the Seminole Boosters' endowment program was



created in 1987. David and Jeannie are pictured here dressed in the ceremonial gowns when Florida State honored them for their exceptional leadership and financial contributions to the University.

David sent his annual gift of \$100 in March, and an additional gift of \$400 more with this notation. **"I would like to also pay for past years going back to the reconstitution of the Old Guard in 2014, as I missed giving in those years. "My Pike Brothers,

"Over the years, we've looked for opportunities to have reunions at locations like Key West, and sometimes Brothers suggest other possible locations. With that in mind we're officially going forward with the first annual **"Back to School" at the Delta Lambda Pike house** in Tallahassee.

"This is your opportunity to spend up to four days in your Delta Lambda fraternity house. When the semester ends in April. Rooms in the Pike house will be open for our use from **28 April to 4 May**. The goal is to foster Delta Lambda Brotherhood while having a great time. Undergrads remaining in the house will get quality time with alumni Brothers in every career imaginable, spend quality time networking with each other.

"I waited until we had "buy in" by all the undergrads, and I'm happy to say they love the idea. I envision up to 30 alumni participating. The period we are targeting is 28 April - 4 May. We chose a 4-day period in that envelope based on participating alumni availability, and undergrad occupancy in the house. Commencement is April 30. The plan is to develop an excel spreadsheet of room availability similar to Airbnb, and to allocate rooms based on number of days each alumnus will participate.

Your Cost:

"Each participating alum will make a donation to the house of approximately \$125 per day/per room. The bulk of the money will help the undergrad with the monthly cost of their May rent. The remaining portion will go to the house, to use to better the house.

Logistics:

"Each alumnus will have their own sheets and mattress protector for obvious reasons. We will inspect each room in the days before the event to ensure all rooms are clean, fit, and up to standards. If you need help obtaining items, let me know.

Events:

"This is going to be more fun than you can imagine. We will have a golf day, an FSU baseball game day (we already have 30 seats in a box, with more available), and we will have a day at Lake Talquin. Other events will be planned once we see the actual numbers.

"Each day, we will have planned meal outings for alumni; alumni will pay for any undergrads who come eat with us. We will have a stickball championship, and other events at the house that further Brotherhood, and allow you to relive your glory days. I'm hoping we can have a Special Initiation so we can re-live and embrace our Ritual and other traditions.

"I'm working on the Excel spreadsheet, **but for now please respond directly to me saying that you would like to participate in this historical event.** Give me the

dates in the period of 28 April to 4 May that you would be available to participate. Keep in mind: graduation is that weekend, so flight reservations may be tough. I'm not sure how many rooms we will have available, so it's first-come, first-served.

"There are a few of us with houses in Tallahassee, so if you don't get (or don't want) a room in the Pike house, then we can probably make space for you."

Josh Williamson '17 (above and right) is still an undergraduate Pike at FSU. Four years after beginning his bobsled training, Williamson, who already holds two World Cup bronze medals, made his Olympic debut at the Beijing 2022 Winter Olympics.

Marvin Bracy '13. Rio de Janeiro, Brazil, 2016 Bracy came in third in the 100 meters at the U.S. Olympic Trials qualifying for the 2016 Summer Olympics. He won three straight U.S. National Championships at 60 meters in 2014-16.

Marvin was on the Seminole football roster as a receiver in 2012. In 2017 and 2018 he was on the roster of the Indianapolis Colts, and is continuing his career in professional track. Last fall, 2021, Marvin Bracy ran a 9.85 100 meters to place #2 in the world.

Bob Bowman '85. Coach Bowman was one of a large number of varsity swimmers who joined Delta Lambda in the early 1980s. He was Team Captain his senior year.

In addition to being the primary coach for Michael Phelps, Bob was Coach of the 2004 Olympic Swim Team, and also the 2012 Olympic Swim Team. His Wiki page mentions his membership in Pi Kappa Alpha
