


#### Join the Old Guard of Delta Lambda!

Delta Lambda remains Florida State's top fraternity because of rush, and rush has already begun for the summer. In our most successful years, Pike has locked in the majority of their new pledges before fall rush officially starts.

The Legacy Rush is a frequent source of triumph to Delta Lambda. Pike fathers send their sons to Florida State, and they make sure the Chapter is contacted well in advance.

Unfortunately, sometimes, the Chapter is NOT contacted in advance, and the Legacy Rushee might either arrive too late, or he is hi-jacked by a rival fraternity before we see him. "Why this 25-year-old quit partying to 3D print stylish homes in Mexico?

"Girls. Gold. Glory." It's not the typical inspirational spiel you'd expect from a Forbes 30 Under 30 winner, but the 'Three Gs' is exactly what Brett Hagler was pursuing during his early 20s before life took an unexpected turn.

After some divine intervention, the cancer survivor found himself on a plane to the earthquake-ravaged Haiti in 2013 – an experience that would expose him to over 100,000 shattered lives before inspiring him to become one of this generation's most ambitious philanthropists.

By the age of just 25, Hagler retired from the rat race and launched New Story, a notfor-profit organization pioneering a radical solution for ending global homelessness. The answer? 3D printing houses for those who can't afford a roof over their heads.

"I realized that no matter how talented a kid is, how intelligent they are, how much creativity they have... if they don't have the basic needs like food, water and shelter, it doesn't matter how smart your kid is – you're just trying to survive."

Tampa Bay is home to a huge contingent of Pike alumni from all chapters. Our Delta Lambda alumni above – Kresge, Smith and Prescott - are all heavily involved. Loyal Gator Frank Smith is a familiar figure to our Delta Lambda Seminoles, and to all Pikes in the Central Florida area.

Frank Smith's impressive claim to fame rests upon the staggering number of Initiations he has overseen, performing the role of SMC during Formal Initiations at a series of Pike Chapters over the last 53 years.

"I took over the SMC role at initiation in spring, 1968 (at the university of Florida)," Frank says. "As of now, I have had the privilege of performing the Initiation Obligation for 1,704 individual Brothers at the University of Florida, for 804 new initiates at the University of South Florida, plus 384 others including Special Dispensation initiations, chapter Charterings or re-Charterings (including Dela Lambda in 2001) for a total of 2,892."

"I am not doing so many annually now. It would be nice to get over 3,000 but it's never been about the numbers – I have always sought perfection with our Ceremony since a Brother only gets initiated once, and I want it to be the very best experience possible."





The 2020-2021 School Year ended early, as there was no Spring Break this year due to Covid. It was a grim year with no parties, no intramurals, and the total number of FSU fraternity chapters 'in good standing' with the university dropped from a high of 27 to only 13 at the end of this term.

Pike remains the largest fraternity, as we have been continually for 20 years.

Jonathan Levin is the 7th Pike to serve as FSU Student Body President since 2003.

Delta Lambda Chapter maintains a 3.1 overall GPA, and Seminole varsity teams are decorated with the names of Pike stars, including 2021 Baseball Captain Chase Haney '18 and 2020 Football Captain Marvin Wilson '18.

# 2021 Chapter Leaders at the Special Ops (Green Beret, SWAT) Training Camp

Tucked away in a remote location in the west Florida wilderness is a sprawling training camp utilized for advanced instruction by Federal and State special operations units. In a first-of-its-kind invitation involving students, ten hand-picked members of Delta Lambda's leadership team were rewarded with an eye-opening day of adventure, including an introduction and facilities tour by a retired Army Green Beret general. One Pike said, "It's like a Green Beret Fantasy Camp, but with live ammunition".

Following orientation in Special Ops weapons and tactics, the men got to fire Glocks, AR15s and even an AK47, all under the close supervision of trained Special Operations veterans.
