Honored with Surprise Recognition Ceremony

Wednesday evening, April 13, 2022, at **Sembler House**, Charlie Barnes was recognized for more than 50 years of leadership and service to Pi Kappa Alpha Fraternity, and to the Delta Lambda Chapter. Over 100 alumni in attendance, including a half-dozen more via Zoom, witnessed Charlie receive multiple accolades. A framed Resolution from Pike International Fraternity will be permanently placed in the **Legends Room**. Also, a portrait of Charlie is now displayed above the trophy case in the foyer of the house. The inscription reads: "Charles R. Barnes II, The Heartbeat of Delta Lambda."

The event began as the brainchild of the 'Pikes of the '60s' whose own reunion last fall was especially superb. A committee composed of **Dick Klunk '67, Bob Tunkel '66, David Orr '63, Jack McMullen '64, J.L. Milton '62** and **Brent Sembler '78** reached out to **Jimmy Keen '73**. Jimmy had orchestrated the surprise dedication of **Sembler House** just one year ago.

"Jimmy worked his magic in many ways," said Tunkel. "All unknown to Charlie, Jimmy arranged to find a suitable portrait and have it framed. He also coordinated with Pike National to craft the formal Resolution, and create a 'personal' Smythe Award for Charlie to take home. Jimmy also acted as master of ceremonies."

Tunkel also singled out **Joe Feheley '81** for special praise. "Joe coordinated with the

"Our current SMC **Joey Williams '19** was instrumental in coordinating the event, and securing the zoom feed. Many pictures were taken and will be available soon; you will see some of them in the newsletter."



Bill Knight '69 flew from Poland to attend the event. After two tours in Vietnam as a Marine Recon Team Leader, Bill pursued graduate studies at Harvard. That was just the beginning of Bill's eclectic career that included a contract with Warner Brothers Records and touring with the Fagles, Queen. Linda Ronstadt and others.

Bill established the Knight Medical Corporation in the 1980s, sold it, and then joined forces with Homeland Security and The White House Medical Unit as a Subject Matter Expert.

"Charlie, this is important: thank you for your selfless Service, Friendship and genuine love for Pi Kappa Alpha...and especially Delta Lambda Chapter.
Since you asked how I journeyed to be with you tonight. here is the tale."

"I began the 640Km drive from Tarnow, Poland on Monday, April 11th to Vienna, Austria where I was to embark on an AA Flight across the pond, landing at Kennedy and connecting into Charlotte with 3-hour layover, and then on to Tallahassee, arrival time-11:40 am on Wednesday.

"At least that was the plan.

"However, it was just outside of Bratislava, Slovakia (some 450km into the trip) when I first learned that my trip and AA travel were no longer the same...radically changed due to very poor weather and storms in NY...my plan was no longer AA's plan...my flight from Kennedy to Vienna had been cancelled due to this weather.

"Took a right turn in Austria and started my own "Great Race" mission, driving another 330km to PRG (Vaclav Havel Airport) in Prague when I remembered my ace in the hole: White House/Secret Service/Homeland Security credentials...So I placed a call to the US Embassy in Prague...

"The Embassy found me another series of flights. Then I called a staffer at the White House Medical Unit in DC and asked them to call JFK to request an 'expedite' for yours truly...coming to Tallahassee on a 'humanitarian' mission.

"The flight that made up the segment from ATL and Tallahassee, experienced mechanical issue and once again, an obstacle arose.

"Now, 10:15 am...Had all my stuff with me, left the Hartsfield airport, secured a car rental...and drove the last 425km to our Delta Lambda Pike house...arrived at 5:45pm.

"1000 KM on the ground...7,764 KM in the air...each way!

"The return trip was, as you might anticipate, far more straight forward. Wrapping up here in Tallahassee and heading to Warsaw...then home. God willing.

"Charlie, I as I told you, you completely changed my Trajectory in life...I am truly Blessed that God placed you in my life!

Fact of the matter is that I would have traveled from ANYWHERE to thank you for what you did for me...just seemed like the right thing to do!"

We will meet again and laugh till we cry about all this and so much more...meanwhile, take Great care of you and your family."
