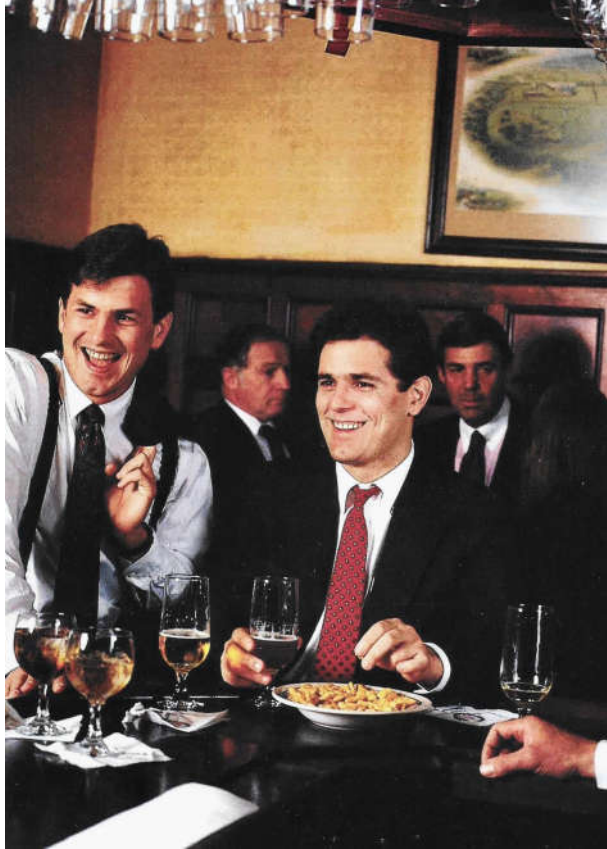

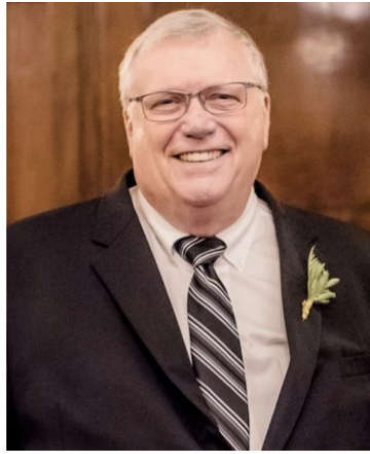

Ken was a graduate of FSU and a member of Pi Kappa Alpha Fraternity. He was Chief Financial Officer of Ajax Building Corporation in Tallahassee."
