

esigned by the award-winning architectural firm of Elliot Marshall Innes, Pi Kappa Alpha's house was dedicated by Delta Lambda Chapter's alumni in 2005. With more than 40,000 square feet under one roof, ours is the largest fraternity house in America. In addition, the 7,000 square foot enclosed courtyard is an artificial turf playground for Pike brothers and their guests.

#### TODAY

The Delta Lambda Chapter has secured additional living space for Pike's growing numbers. The chapter amassed overflow housing in the old Delta Chi house located directly behind the main mansion. The house is fitted with 24 rooms that comfortably house 48 brothers. The acquisition allows for a larger number of brothers around the house at all times: further solidifying Pike's dominance in Heritage Grove.

#### DELTA LAMBDA HOUSE HISTORY

1970-2005

Pi Kappa Alpha was established at Florida State in 1948 and was the first fraternity to finance and build their own house. Our 'old' house shown here was built in 1966. Nestled beneath majestic oaks, it stood on a large portion of private land in the middle of FSU's campus. Located in those days on the corner of Jefferson Street and Wildwood, this columned mansion was home to one of the nation's most legendary fraternity chapters.
