


Chasing the Bulls in Pamplona, Spain

Our boys making a 2022 summer European tour of Prague, Munich, Barcelona, Zaragoza, and ending in Pamplona for the annual Running of the Bulls.






The Aguayo Brothers with Parents Roberto, Sr and Martina.

Seminole Team Captains **Roberto '12** and **Ricky '16 Aguayo** are two of the most storied kickers in Seminole history.

Ricky was an ESPN Freshman All-American. His 6 FG in one game set a record. Ranked fifth all-time at FSU in scoring with 329 points, his PAT percentage of .982 ranked second in school history behind his brother Roberto... His FG percentage of .705 was seventh in school history...Ricky finished career perfect 85-for-85 on PATs in ACC play.

Roberto was a three-time, First Team All-American, and winner of the Lou Groza Award in 2013. In July 2021, ESPN named Roberto Aguayo as part of their all-time collegiate "*Special Teams Mount Rushmore*", alongside Sebastian Janikowski, Shane Lechler, and Braden Mann. Roberto learned to recite The Preamble from his long snapper **Phil Doumar '09**. "I wouldn't give him the extra snaps he wanted in practice until he could quote it back to me."







Zachary Schindler '21 and Kyle Hill '16 in Washington, DC.





He made life an adventure and wouldn't want this news to stop the joy of this season.




