Jordan Travis '22

On November 12th 2022, Jordan Travis duplicated Kelly Lowrey's 1982 record of scoring multiple touchdowns three different ways against one opponent, by running, catching and throwing. Travis did it against Syracuse; Kelly against Ohio State.

"I did it in 2 games," says Kelly. "In 1981 I scored on a faked field goal. In 1982 I caught and threw a pass... So, I hold the record against Ohio State as the only player to run, throw and catch a pass in a career. So glad to hear Jordan Travis is a Pike!"

Until 1982, Ohio State had not lost back-to-back home games to one opponent in consecutive seasons since 1902.

Jordan is on the watch list for several national awards, and should be mentioned in the race for the Heisman in 2023.


FSU Football's Dillan Gibbons named the winner of the 2022 Wuerffel Trophy



One of Delta Lambda's most popular, generous and accomplished alumni entered Chapter Eternal in November. Former SMC **Bobby Jones '72** was brother-in-law to both **Andy Miller '70** and **Bill Miller '74**, and uncle to **Matt Miller '09**.

After earning his Bachelor's in Finance & Accounting in 1975, in later years Bobby founded The BYSIS Group, Inc. which became present day Ascensus, the nation's largest independent retirement and college savings services provider. He eventually retired as Partner in the private equity firm Bluff Point.

Bobby was inducted into the FSU College of Business Hall of Fame in 2016, and served on the Investment Board of Advisors of the State of Florida Retirement System. He was also Chairman of the FSU Foundation Board, and served as a Governor-appointed member of the FSU Board of Trustees.

An avid golfer, Bobby raised \$28 million for cancer research through association with his golf partners.

One of his regular golf partners was **John O'Hurley**, the actor who played the role of **J. Peterman**, the real-life catalogue/clothing entrepreneur who was parodied on the old **Seinfeld** TV series.

When the parent company went bankrupt, Bobby and O'Hurley thought it would be a hoot to buy the company and let O'Hurley be the 'real' J. Peterman! Bobby and O'Hurley repurchased the name and restarted the company. At the time of his death, Bobby was still part owner, and served on the J. Peterman Company Board of Directors.
