
Identical twins Bob and Jim Ferdinand '62.

This photo was discovered in a cache of promotional pictures in the University's permanent archives. We suppose the idea of identical twins was such a curiosity to FSU in those days that the school staged a promotional photo of the freshmen, hitchhiking from Miami to Tallahassee to begin classes. Note that they are wearing the traditional 'freshman beanie".

They were part of Delta Lambda's fall, 1961 pledge class. Post-graduation, both twins attended Dental School in Louisville where they received their Doctor of Medicine in Dentistry. After earning Masters Degrees in Orthodontics, they opened practices in Windemere and Orlando

Both brothers served in the Army. Jim entered Chapter Eternal in 2001; Bob followed in 2020. The Ferdinands are the first case of identical twins in Delta Lambda (and possibly Florida State) history.

It sounds unlikely, even amazing, but we have been able to identify **eleven sets of** identical twins who have come through the Delta Lambda Chapter doors since the Ferdinand brothers arrived in 1960.



Identical twins **Terry** and **Tommy Anton '75** came to Florida State on varsity golf scholarships in the fall of 1974. They were very active in the Chapter, and played golf two years for the Seminoles before transferring to the University of Florida, where they remained active in Alpha Eta Chapter. As seniors, the boys were named All-SEC in golf. The twins' older brother **Bill Anton '68** was initiated at the University of Nebraska




Left: Identical twins Nicholas and Vincent Raffaele '15.






Left: **Identical twins Anthony and Thomas Cattolico '20**. Their home is Philadelphia. Go Eagles!







Long before Pikeboy and Pikes Illustrated, Delta Lambda published their first rush booklet, in 1966. The new house was not completed until 1967, but the artist's rendering is pretty accurate. The interior photos and text were well done, but because there was a photo of Brothers drinking beer, the University made Pike take an ink pad and blot out the offending photo in every one of the booklets. There's no attribution inside, but memory suggests that **Bob Humphries '66** and **Craig Kavka '66** compiled the book. **Jim Poe '66** might have had something to do with it too.
