
2022 CHEEZ-IT BOWL VICTORY OVER OKLAHOMA

Several alumni pronounced this Seminole victory to be a "Pike Win". Quarterback **Jordan Travis '22** and receiver **Johnny Wilson '22** brought the ball down the field for a touchdown on the final drive, and **Ryan Fitzgerald '19** kicked the FG to put the game away. Punter **Alex Mastromano '21** contributed to the win, along with offensive linemen **Thomas Schrader '21**, **Bryan Estes '21** and 2022 Wuerffel Trophy winner **Dillan Gibbons '21**.

It wasn't an easy victory for the Noles, but they were able to escape Orlando with their 10th win of the season — the best for the program since 2016. Florida State defeated the Sooners 35-32 behind incredible performances from Jordan Travis and Johnny Wilson.

Post season: Jordan Travis '22 named "Most Valuable Player for 2022", and Johnny Wilson '22 named "Best Offensive Player for 2022".
