We were like ghosts, older men in the shadows, our arms crossed in the Sign of the Order, as if we were watching younger versions of ourselves repeating the old Ritual. These things – the Ritual, and Phi Phi Kappa Alpha – continue to unite Delta Lambdas across time and generations.

It is with sadness that we report the death of **Bill Miller '74**, known as 'Gator' because of his red hair and big smile. A handsome and happy Brother, he came to Pi Kappa Alpha during the time of our greatest growth and triumph. He fit perfectly within his large Pike family; he enjoyed being with his brother **Andy Miller '70** and brother-

in-law **Bobby Jones '72** during chapter days. Later, he was the favorite uncle of **Matt Miller '09**. His sister **Susan Miller Jones** was a Pike Little Sister.

Bill is pictured here with his beloved daughters Lauren and Kate. His obituary begins, "What you leave behind is not what is engraved in stone monuments, but what is woven into the lives of others."

Comments of grief and remembrance flowed from fellow Pike alumni. Here are a few.

Bob Coury '72, "I am so sorry to hear of Bill's passing. I have such fond memories of Bill when we first became Pike Fraternity brothers almost 50 years ago. Although our paths have not crossed in many years, just the mention of Bill Miller's name brings a smile to your face. He was such a funny, loving guy with that mischievous look that was always ready to party. Bill will be greatly missed, but he was a wonderful blessing to all who knew him, especially those of us who were fortunate enough to call him Brother. Phi Phi Brother Bill."

Ed Barnes '71, "I remember one Sunday afternoon conversation in the Spring, sitting on the front porch of the Pike House, having cold beers with Bill and several other Brothers from Gadsden County.

There were a bunch of us, enjoying the Spring weather, laughing and telling stories. They were feeding off each other, telling tales, and had us all laughing. Bill Miller and **Taylor Bud Williams '74** spun the best yarns. I couldn't tell you today what they were about, but I remember the warm feeling of comradery that we were all sharing.

A sense of humor counts for something in this world, and Bill Miller was one of the best with a knack for entertaining his Brothers with a good story."

Jimmy Keen '73, "Regarding Bill, I used the nicknames 'Gator' and 'Buck' because I knew him as both. I am deeply saddened to hear that Brother Miller entered Chapter Eternal; he was far too young and far too full of life and joy, and he always brought happiness to his friends and Brothers. Bill was a consummate gentleman, soft spoken and he was always there to offer his help. I remember Gator inviting several of us Brothers to Havana for deer hunting and dinner with his parents. I am a better PiKA for knowing Gator and the legacy of true friendship he left behind." Jimmy

Cliff Davenport '73, "Bill was essential for us with the Havana/Quincy/Greensboro that came together and stayed close. He and his guys established a character that balanced the South Florida 'internationalism' in the chapter. Bill and his core Brothers kept us grounded with hunting, fishing, BBQ and other "Southern Country" activities that were important then, and remain so today. Bill was a good man, a loyal friend and Pike Brother whose character, buttressed by his older brother **Andy Miller '70**, was materiel in building the PiKA that we all cherish today."

Jim Smalley '73, "Bill Miller, aka 'Gator', was one of the nicest, most easy-going and easy to like people I have ever known. I cannot remember him not smiling. He was blessed with a fabulous heart and a great sense of humor. I don't believe Bill ever said a bad word about anybody, and he was trustworthy to a fault. He came from a wonderful family, and that showed in all he did. I deeply regret not seeing Bill more in the last few years, because every moment with him was a pleasure. As sad as we all are to learn of his passing, we know that God smiles on good souls, and Bill was a great one."
