Delta Lambda Chapter is getting ready to Launch the next generation of the Digital experience! The Delta Lambda Pikes new web-site is coming soon.






Left: **Tracy Schulis '76** meeting the "Jersey Challenge" to wear the same Pike jersey you wore in college.


